

Dear All,

I have completed the first month of my tour! Thank you for the warm reception and many goodies. I pray my ministry

among you is being fruitful. Ultimately, this is an instance of the Gospel command: love of neighbor as yourself. Love of neighbor is not just transactional; true Christian love is transformative: when we love our neighbor, the hope is that they experience God's love, and that we receive God's love through their actions—each of us is transformed by His love.

During my time—in addition to just getting familiar with your community, I enjoyed meeting you, visiting the schools and parish ministries—I have also been called to the hospital and to individual homes to offer the Sacrament of Anointing. This ministry is very satisfying, and also challenging, and rarely given—mostly because the sacrament is probably the most misunderstood and underutilized of sacraments. The Catechism (CCC) states:

- ...as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. (1514)
- It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation, the same holds for the elderly whose frailty becomes more pronounced. (1515)

With this Church's understanding of the sacrament, I encourage those families that have individuals confined to their home because of acute illness or aging contact the office and ask for the priest to bring of the Sacrament. The Sacrament provides for the healing activity of the Holy Spirit—through the remission of sin, a blessing, and the opportunity to receive the Blessed Sacrament if the person is able to swallow. This sacrament is more fully experienced by the person receiving the sacrament when, if possible, family members are present.

Additionally, I hope you realize if you are scheduled for a serious surgical intervention, you are able to receive the sacrament prior to the intervention. Please make the request to the deacon or to me, prior to Mass, and I will offer you the Sacrament after Mass on the weekend PRIOR to the surgical intervention. And, of course, always call the emergency line, if you or a family member is rushed to the hospital.

Along a similar vein, I also realized that, even though, you have a very active homebound ministry to the local nursing homes, we do not have individuals who have stepped forward to bring communion to homebound elderly. I, personally, am available to bring communion to these individuals. Please contact the office and request a communion visit, I will call you back to arrange for a timely visit.

ALSO, if you feel called to this special aspect of homebound ministry, (especially if have a homebound family yourself) please let the office know. I will arrange to meet with you to discuss the ministry. One thing any homebound minister will attest you to, each minister to a person, is they receive more from the visit than the person they are visiting—and that person is receiving the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Our Lord Himself. Again, here is an instance of the true dimension of the Gospel commandment: love of neighbor is transformative.

Whitewater Pro Bono






