



Dear All,

This weekend we celebrate both the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent and Christmas, 2023! The fourth candle of Advent repre-

sents LOVE, and Christmas is the unique expression of God's love for us. God comes as a baby child, an expression of love which can only evoke love from us. God goes to lengths to demonstrate to us how much He loves us and how much He wants us to love Him. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: to love our neighbor as ourselves. This is the simple message of Christ, of Christmas.

It is our hope as Christians to carry this message throughout the year: to grow more in love of God, and in love of neighbor, so that we can advance in holiness. As we approach the New Year, I suggest that you add one small devotional prayer practice which you can do in your family. If you are not saying a prayer before meals, begin this year! If you are not praying with your children before bed, begin this year! If you are not reading your bible at least 20 minutes a day, begin this year. There are many different apps on your phone which can support you, such as Hallow, or Ascension, or even our own Seton Catholic FB, where you can join the parish family in the daily rosary at 7:30 pm. If you are not doing one charitable activity, at least once monthly, begin this year.

Spend this last week praying and thinking about what new devotional practice you can begin on January 1, 2024.

- Recommended weekday times are 6:00AM-8:00PM. There are also times you may want to avoid visiting the church - Saturday mornings are usually reserved for the setup of the weekend Masses. Funerals, school services, weekday Masses, or rosary prayer times are also common events that would take precedence over private prayer time.
- Please sign-in, a sign-in sheet is available in the back of church.






