

Dear All,

Thanks to Fr. Sengole for his invitation to step in while he was on sabbatical, and to the Archbishop who allowed me a share of

his ministry in the Archdiocese, especially here in Richmond.

Thanks to each of you for the warm welcome I received when I arrived in October, and for the kind send off last weekend. It has been a real joy to stand in for Fr. Sengole. Like St. Joseph, I knew I was a temporary father to this faith community. I pray that I performed this fatherly duty so that your community could "grow in wisdom, age and grace." Unfortunately, unlike Joseph, I could not lead silently just by example. I guess I am more a Franciscan: "Preach the gospel at all times; use words if necessary." I thought I needed words.

I have stood with you at the foot of the Cross by presiding at Mass—the unbloody sacrifice of the cross—at which we may invited to the wedding banquet, to receive His body, blood, soul and divinity—the nourishment we need to live out our Baptismal commitment.

I have been honored to deliver the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing to the spiritually and physically ill among us. Through MapQuest, I was able to negotiate my way through—what seemed like the multiple directions of the City—to visit you in nursing homes, at Reid hospital, and visits of the homebound. Thank you for inviting me to share in your joys and your sorrows. Sadly, there were many funerals during this time. We pray that your loved ones are in peace and you are comforted.

I enjoyed the opportunity to share my time and insights on the rosary and the psalms as well as the chance to share reflections with the men's and women's group. I loved presenting to the RCIA classes, and my "hello" visits to the schools, and the confirmation class. I was honored to be there for Confirmation at Connersville and the Rite of Enrollment at the Cathedral.

Thank you for the many "good-bye" notes and gifts I have received. Through this note, I am saying a personal "thank you" to each of you. I enjoyed the social times I have spent with you. I will take all these memories with me.


