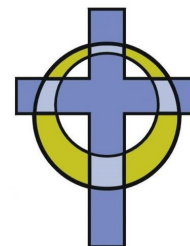

## Words from our Pastor

October 31, 2021

XXXI Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are near the end of the liturgical year, and the readings invite us to review our ways of living, to be prepared to meet Jesus as our Supreme King. How do we live the commandments of God's law? Do we know the ten commandments and what each of them implies? If we know them that is good because we are close to salvation, we only need to live them to do the will of God. Live the will of God and join the community in Jesus Christ who is our only high priest, who summons us daily to live and remember his sacrifice for us, to redeem our sins. Jesus listening to the scribe today in the Gospel that says: "Loving God and neighbor is much better than offering sacrifices and burnt offerings." Without a doubt, man has discovered that he can do many acts of piety, many offerings, sacrifices, but if you do not love God above all things and your neighbor, our traditions are nothing. For those, it is important to attend the memorial of Jesus every Sunday, and to be always there from the beginning of the entrance song until the end of the closing song, because the Eucharist is a complete prayer, I hope we get to know more and more to live. better our love for God at Mass, the exclusive moment for God normally 60 minutes, unique and exclusive to worship God. Asking for forgiveness, listening to his word, applying it to our lives, receiving the body of Jesus and receiving his blessing so that we can do very well in the following days, and thanking him with the last song as a prayer of thanks for having been with Jesus. Let us ask God to help us more each day to know him, love him and serve him in our brothers, so we will live the commandments of God much better.
