

Words from our Pastor

March 19, 2023
Dear sisters and brothers



"The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want." This Sunday, called "Laetare" Sunday, is the Sunday of joy, joy that gives us knowing that life in Christ does not end with the sacrifice of the cross; but, like Christ, is the resurrection, living eternal life in God. If we trust God, he as a good shepherd, will always lead us through safe paths and green pastures. Today, in the first reading we hear how God chooses not who we as humans think would be the best option. God makes himself present in the least, to let us know that God can use the smallest thing to manifest himself and show his greatness. A little shepherd is

the one who leads the community to lead it to glory, to the conquest of the Philistines. Today's gospel lets us see that power of God so that everyone is able to see its wonders, the disease that in Jesus' time was considered a curse because of sins and sometimes the sins of the ancestors. Christ explains to his disciples that this has happened so that the manifestation of God becomes present, Jesus is the light of the world who comes to illuminate the life of those who walk in the dark, who do not dare to look that God is in their lives, regardless of time or circumstances, God is present in those who blindly trust Him. At times in our lives, we can live in darkness, but when we begin to know Christ, things change and we see the light, and the fruits of those who receive the light of Christ is goodness, holiness, and truth. Thus, Saint Paul says: "Awake, you who sleep; rise from the dead and Christ will be your light" Eph. 5, 14. Let us look and follow the only light that opens our eyes and keeps us alert in life. Lord may the darkness in which we live be transformed when we receive you in the Eucharist today, that upon receiving it, it becomes the light in our lives and so we live doing good works that make us light for our brothers, especially those who need it most, Amen.

Going to Confession in Twelve Easy Steps

1. Examine your conscience, call to mind your sins, and then enter the confessional.
2. The priest will welcome and receive you.
3. Make the sign of the cross and say: "In the name of the Father and the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."
4. The priest will invite you to trust in God. He may also read a text of Sacred Scripture.
5. Say these or similar words:
"Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been _____ long since my last confession. These are my sins..."
6. Tell the priest your sins. Then say these or similar words: "For these and all of my sins, I am sorry."
7. Accept your work of penance (*prayers, act of kindness, etc.*) to help make satisfaction and amend your life.
8. Express your sorrow for your sins (*Act of contrition*) in these or similar words:
"O my God, I am sorry and repent with all my heart for all the wrong I have done And for the good I have failed to do, because by sinning I have offended you, who all good and worthy to be loved above all things. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid the occasions of sin. Through the merits of the Passion of our Savior Jesus Christ, Lord have mercy."
9. Receive God's forgiveness as the priest prays the Prayer of Absolution.
10. At the end of the prayer of Absolution, reply: "Amen."
11. Give praise to God. When the priest says: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good," conclude: "For his mercy endures forever."
12. Go in peace and remember to say or do your penance.

Ir a la confesión en doce sencillos pasos

1. Examine su conciencia, recuerde sus pecados y luego entre al confesonario.
2. El sacerdote le dará la bienvenida y los recibirá.
3. Hacer la señal de la cruz y decir: "En el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén."
4. El sacerdote te invitará a confiar en Dios. También puede leer un texto de la Sagrada Escritura.
5. Diga estas u otras palabras similares:
"Bendícame Padre porque he pecado. Ha pasado _____ mucho tiempo desde mi última confesión. Estos son mis pecados..."
6. Dile al sacerdote tus pecados. Luego diga estas u otras palabras similares: "Por estos y todos mis pecados, lo siento".
7. Aceptar su trabajo de penitencia (*oraciones, actos de caridad, etc.*) para ayudar a satisfacer y enmendar su vida.
8. Expresa tu dolor por tus pecados (*Acto de contrición*) con estas u otras palabras similares:
"Oh mi Dios, lo siento y me arrepiento de todo corazón por todo el mal que he hecho Y por el bien que he dejado de hacer, porque pecando te he ofendido a ti, que eres todo bueno y digno de ser amado sobre todas las cosas. Resuelvo firmemente, con la ayuda de vuestra gracia, hacer penitencia, no pecar más y evitar las ocasiones de pecado. Por los méritos de la Pasión de nuestro Salvador Jesucristo, Señor, ten piedad".
9. Recibir el perdón de Dios mientras el sacerdote reza la Oración de Absolución.
10. Al final de la oración de Absolución, responde: "Amén".
11. Dar alabanza a Dios. Cuando el sacerdote dice: "Dad gracias al Señor, porque es bueno", concluye:
"Porque para siempre es su misericordia".
12. Ve en paz y recuerda decir o hacer tu penitencia.
