

Words from our Pastor

April 30, 2023

Fourth Sunday of Easter



After looking at the testimonies of the resurrection of Jesus, the apostles who discover the empty tomb, Thomas who did not believe until he saw him and verified the marks of the crucifixion, the disciples of Emmaus, with sadness and lack of hope, go back to his town. All the disciples after recognizing Christ change their way of seeing life and reinforce their faith, the words of Jesus make them return to their origins of how they met Jesus. There is a conversion, a change of life in each of the people who know Jesus or who discover him their life experiences. It is from there on that they follow Jesus more firmly, later in the acts of the apostles we will find how all the followers of Jesus who convert by the proclamation of the good news of the apostles and repent of their sins, start a new life in the community, recognizing in others a community of brothers in whom they discover the face of God and meet at the fraction of bread, putting everything in common. Following the example of Christ, we should always do

what is good and just in the eyes of God regardless of the sacrifice we must suffer. Today Jesus the good shepherd invites us to enter through the sheepfold door, to do things as we should, without seeking our own benefits, but thinking about the community. Alleged shepherds will come who will care only for their benefit, sacrificing many times only the sheep, without instructing them on the correct door. Let us ask God to help us to always know how to do what corresponds to us as sheep that follow the good shepherd, listening to his voice and following him, knowing that Jesus will always lead us as a good shepherd to green, good and safe pastures. Likewise, let us ask God for our pastors, priests, bishops who shepherd our communities, that we give our lives following the example of Christ by doing what we have to do, teaching and sanctifying the flocks entrusted to us and that following the example of Christ we lead them to conversion and repentance of their sins and so we live as a true community in Jesus who has risen and continues to rise in our lives.

Después de mirar los testimonios de la resurrección de Jesús, los apóstoles que descubren la tumba vacía, Tomás que no creía hasta verlo y verificar las marcas de la crucifixión, los discípulos de Emaús, que con tristeza y faltos de esperanza, van de regreso a su pueblo. Todos los discípulos después de reconocer a Cristo cambian su forma de ver la vida y refuerzan su fe, las palabras de Jesús los hacen volver a sus orígenes de como conocieron a Jesús. Existe una conversión, un cambio de vida en cada una de las personas que conocen a Jesús o que descubren en sus experiencias de vida. Pidamos a Dios nos ayude a saber siempre hacer lo que nos corresponde como ovejas que siguen al buen pastor, escuchando su voz y seguirlo, sabiendo que Jesús nos llevara siempre como buen pastor a pastos verdes, buenos y seguros. Así mismo pidamos a Dios por nuestros pastores, sacerdotes, obispos que pastorean nuestras comunidades, que entreguemos nuestras vidas a ejemplo de Cristo haciendo lo que tenemos, enseñar y santificar los rebaños a nosotros encargados y que a ejemplo de Cristo los llevemos a una conversión y arrepentimiento de sus pecados y así vivamos como una verdadera comunidad en Jesús que ha resucitado y sigue resucitando en nuestras vidas.
