





Words from our Pastor

January 28, 2024
Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

How many things worry us in life? What things do we consider essential in our lives? Last week we heard the way Jesus calls his first disciples, the two sets of brothers; Jesus calls them to follow him from their own environment, in their work times, in the company of their family, and they, leaving everything behind, followed him. How many times do the worries of life become an obstacle to following Jesus? How has our attention been to Jesus' call to follow him? In the story of Israel, God makes the promise of a prophet who will speak in his name, a prophet who will manifest himself completely in the name of God, a man with the power of authority, we believe that this prophet is Jesus. In the Gospel, we hear Jesus preaching in the synagogue and people are amazed by his way of speaking with authority, an authority to which even evil spirits feel subjected. Sadly, in many cases the only ones who recognize Jesus as "the Son of God" are the evil spirits, while followers can be distracted by the things in our lives, our worries that do not allow us to contemplate the presence of God in our lives. Saint Paul, in his letter to the Corinthians, talks to them about how, depending on the state of life of each person, there are certain concerns, but we must also think about fulfilling the will of God in our lives, to worry about the things of God that God is already taking care of. Let us ask God to know how to trust Him, to trust in his promises, those promises that lead us to live in continuous hope that God will always be by our side. Let us listen carefully to his word, that word of authority that invites us to change our way of being and thinking about the things of God. May the Blessed Virgin Mary be our teacher in knowing how to listen and recognize the presence of God in our lives.



Unas palabras de nuestro Pastor

¿Cuántas cosas nos preocupan en la vida? ¿Qué cosas consideramos como esenciales en nuestra vida? La semana pasada escuchábamos la manera como Jesus llama a sus primeros discípulos, a las dos parejas de hermanos; Jesus los llama a seguirlo desde sus ambientes propios, en sus tiempos de trabajo, en la compañía de su familia y ellos dejándolo todo lo siguieron. ¿Cuántas veces las preocupaciones de la vida se convierten en obstáculo para seguir a Jesus? ¿Cómo ha sido nuestra atención al llamado de Jesus a seguirlo? En la historia de Israel Dios hace la promesa de un profeta que hablará en su nombre, un profeta que se manifestara completamente en nombre de Dios, un hombre con poder de autoridad, nosotros creemos que ese profeta es Jesus. En el Evangelio, escuchamos a Jesus que predica en la sinagoga y la gente se queda asombrada por su forma de hablar con autoridad, una autoridad a la que se sienten sometidos hasta los malos espíritus. Tristemente en mucho de los casos los únicos que reconocen a Jesus como "el Hijo de Dios" son los malos espíritus, mientras los seguidores podemos estar distraídos en las cosas de nuestras vidas, nuestras preocupaciones que no nos dejan contemplar la presencia de Dios en nuestra vida. San Pablo en la carta a los corintios, les habla de cómo según el estado de vida de cada persona existen ciertas preocupaciones, pero debemos también pensar en cumplir la voluntad de Dios en nuestras vidas, preocuparnos de las cosas de Dios que ya Dios se está ocupando de las nuestras. Pidamos a Dios saber confiar en él, confiar en sus promesas, esas promesas que nos llevan a vivir en una esperanza continua de que Dios siempre estará a nuestro lado. Escuchemos atentamente su palabra, esa palabra de autoridad que nos invita al cambio de estar y pensar en las cosas de Dios. Que la Santísima Virgen María sea nuestra maestra en saber escuchar y reconocer la presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas.

Beautiful Eucharist



At the Christmas masses the parish gave all families the book *Beautiful Eucharist*. Today we share with you a synopsis of Chapter 3. If you did not receive a copy of the book, please look for books in the Narthex. Lisa Hendey, author and blogger, was raised immersed in Catholicism. Her parish felt like home. During years of Catholic schooling she learned spiritual discipline, generosity, that God loved her unconditionally, and that the church needed her participation. Her pastor taught her to read, share, and live scripture. Fr. also taught her that the Eucharist was the true Presence of Jesus Christ. Because Jesus was truly present in the Eucharist, Lisa longed to experience daily communion. Lisa has been sustained in her life by the True Presence. Lisa tells us that the Eucharist is not a potion for power, but more like a warm hug that inspires us to share with those around us. Lisa's book recommendation is *77 Ways to Pray with Your Kids* by Jerry Windley – Daoust.
