BULLETIN ANNOUNCEMENTS

FAITH FORMATION SUNDAY: This Sunday, February 11 the 3rd & 4th Grade Class will be hosting a breakfast after Mass. Please join them in the Parish Hall.

NO FAITH FORMATION: There will be no Faith Formation Classes this Wednesday, February 14 since it is ASH WEDNESDAY. Please plan to attend Mass with your family instead: 5:15 p.m. in Watford City or 7:00 p.m. in Alexander.

LENT: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own sui iuris Churches.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the “paschal fast” to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

POVERTY MEAL: Following Stations of the Cross at 6:00 p.m. on Fridays during Lent, there will be a Poverty Meal served in the Parish Hall.
