SPOTLIGHT ON CURRICULUM CONFIRMATION

A new program called DECISION POINT by
Matthew Kelly (Dynamic Catholic) will be introduced to our Confirmation students this year.
DECISION POINT is the first Confirmation program specifically developed to engage young Catholics in a meaningful conversation about the genius of Catholicism. It teaches and inspires teens to respond to God's grace. The content meets teens where they are in their everyday lives.

Some of the topics explored are "Your Choices Matter", "God's Dream for You", "Why Pray" and I "Jesus was a Radical". The program encourages thought, reflection, discussion and action.

Additionally, our 10th graders who will be confirmed in the spring will be familiarized with apologetics. We want our teens to be able to articulate why they believe in Jesus Christ, why they are Catholic and want them to respond with conviction and confidence in their faith.
