We are well aware of Pentecost and the event which gave life to the church. The event at the Jordan speaks of the same Holy Spirit, present at Jesus' baptism. Think about the words in John's gospel. The Spirit was visible like the wind, noise and fire at Pentecost. It descended upon Jesus and remained, leading the gospel writer to write 'He is the Son of God.' Later the centurion would echo this same profound statement.

At our confirmation the same Spirit came, and remains, but we are slow to make that special presence and power visible. John said he didn't know Him. Do we? He made us to know, love and serve Him. We are sent to make Him known, loved and served.

ASK A FRANCISCAN...

I found out my coworker was reading and sharing private emails from her boss about personal company matters. I felt compelled to let our human resources office know. Now I am feeling guilty and anxiety-ridden that this person might lose her job. Was I right to report her? Should I simply let it go?

As far as I know, most employee contracts have a clause about not sharing a company's proprietary information. Strictly speaking, this may not have been proprietary information (trademarks, etc.), but it could potentially cause great harm to the company if publicized.

When I consulted Father Dan Kroger, OFM, our publisher who has a doctorate in ethics, he agreed with this response. You may understandably feel some guilt if your coworker loses her job over this, but your only alternative may be to lie, saying in effect, "It's no big deal." Can any genuine virtue be built on a lie to oneself?

Family Connection

The ministry of John the Baptist prepared for and pointed to the ministry of Jesus. In a similar way, our lives are to offer testimony to who we know Jesus to be for us and for the world. Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. How does the witness of our lives give testimony to the reconciling presence of Christ?

Consider how John the Baptist gives testimony to who Jesus is. Talk about what people might come to know about Jesus by observing your family life. Pray together that your family life will show others that Jesus is the Son of God, the lamb who takes away the sins of the world.
