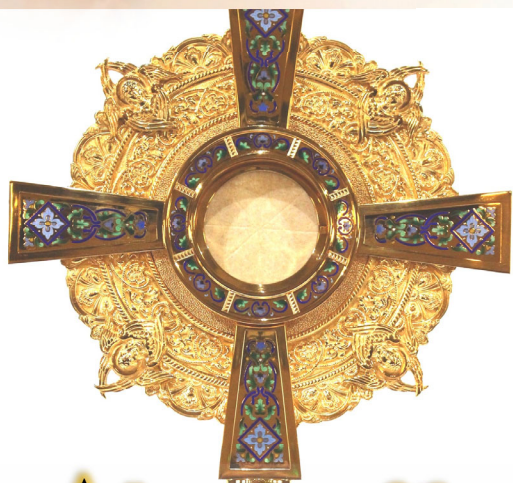

Requirements

- Be a registered member of St. Pius or live within St. Pius boundaries
- Sunday Mass attendance is an ABSOLUTE requirement
- Copy of Baptism Certificate
- Pay the registration Fee the day you register
(or at least pay half on the registration day and the other half the first day of class)
- **Elementary:**
 - Registered-Member: \$60 Non-Registered: \$80
- **Confirmation:**
 - Registered-Member: \$250 (including the retreat) Non-Registered: \$270

Participation

- The Confirmation program is 12 months long. The parents are required to participate in a retreat and come to parent meetings throughout the year.
