Reflexión

El Señor es nuestro guardián, junto a nosotros a nuestra mano derecha, intercediendo por nosotros en todas nuestras batallas espirituales.

En el Salmo de hoy se nos dice que levantemos la vista hacia las montañas, que nuestra ayuda vendrá del Monte Sión y el Templo, la morada del Señor que hizo el cielo y la tierra.

A Joshua y los israelitas, en la primera lectura de hoy, también se les dice que miren a las colinas. Deben encontrar su ayuda allí, por intercesión de Moisés, mientras se defienden de sus enemigos mortales, los amalecitas.

Observe la imagen: Aarón y Hur de pie a cada lado de Moisés, sosteniendo sus brazos cansados para que pueda levantar el bastón de Dios sobre su cabeza. A Moisés se le muestra aquí como una figura de Jesús, que también subió a la cima de una colina, y en el monte Calvario extendió sus manos entre el cielo y la tierra para interceder por nosotros contra el enemigo final: el pecado y la muerte.

Por el personal de Dios, Moisés superó a los enemigos de Israel, separó el Mar Rojo y trajo agua de la Roca.

La Cruz de Jesús es el nuevo bastón de Dios, provocando una nueva liberación del pecado, produciendo aguas vivas del cuerpo de Cristo, el nuevo Templo de Dios.

Al igual que los israelitas y la viuda en el Evangelio de hoy, enfrentamos oposición e injusticia, a veces por parte de adversarios impíos y despiadados.

Nosotros también debemos levantar nuestros ojos a las montañas, al Calvario y al Dios que nos protegerá de todo mal.

Debemos rezar siempre y no cansarnos de nuestras pruebas, nos dice Jesús hoy. Como Pablo exhorta en la Epístola de hoy, debemos permanecer fieles, recurrir a las Escrituras inspiradas, dadas por Dios para entrenarnos en la justicia.

Debemos persistir, de modo que cuando el Hijo del Hombre venga nuevamente en poder real, de hecho, encuentre fe en la tierra.

Reflection

The Lord is our guardian, beside us at our right hand, interceding for us in all our spiritual battles.

In today's Psalm we're told to lift our eyes to the mountains, that our help will come from Mount Zion and the Temple—the dwelling of the Lord who made heaven and earth.

Joshua and the Israelites, in today's First Reading, are also told to look to the hilltops. They are to find their help there—through the intercession of Moses—as they defend themselves against their mortal foes, the Amalekites.

Notice the image: Aaron and Hur standing on each side of Moses, holding his weary arms so that he can raise the staff of God above his head. Moses is being shown here as a figure of Jesus, who also climbed a hilltop, and on Mount Calvary stretched out His hands between heaven and earth to intercede for us against the final enemy—sin and death.

By the staff of God, Moses bested Israel's enemies, parted the Red Sea and brought water from the Rock.

The Cross of Jesus is the new staff of God, bringing about a new liberation from sin, bringing forth living waters from the body of Christ, the new Temple of God.

Like the Israelites and the widow in today's Gospel, we face opposition and injustice—at times from godless and pitiless adversaries.

We, too, must lift our eyes to the mountains—to Calvary and the God who will guard us from all evil.

We must pray always and not be wearied by our trials, Jesus tells us today. As Paul exhorts in today's Epistle, we need to remain faithful, to turn to the inspired Scriptures—given by God to train us in righteousness.

We must persist, so that when the Son of Man comes again in kingly power, He will indeed find faith on earth.

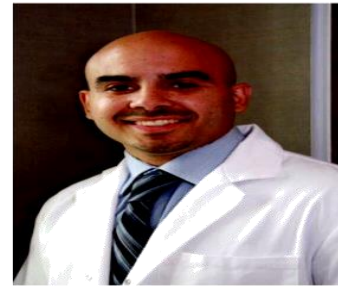

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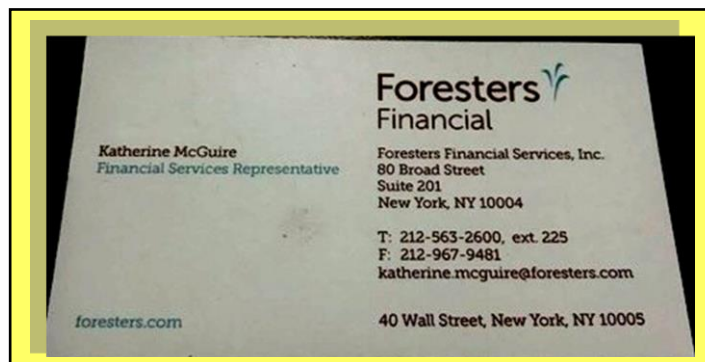

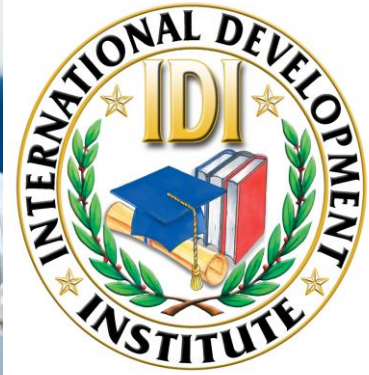
