WELCOME BACK TO CHURCH: As your pastor, I wish to take this opportunity to welcome you back to Church after several months staying away because of Corona virus. As we resume, let us protect one another. How? No paper bulletins will be distributed, but we shall ensure articles are on our parish website both in English and Spanish at Saintangelamericichurch.org/bulletin, we can send you email, flock note and Facebook. Communion will be distributed only via the Host on the hand; A Cantor will be permitted, but not large choirs, Offertory ushers will wear gloves and masks and practice social distancing.

There will be no greeting of people after Mass.
Chairs will be regularly sanitized and disinfected
We please ask anyone with flu-like symptoms to remain home and not come to church.
Parishioners must wear mask
Attendance at each individual Mass will be limited to no more than organized occupancy permitted
No physical contact during the sign of Peace will be permitted
Ushers will wear masks and not make physical contact when greeting parishioners
Orderly arrivals and departures will be coordinated by ushers and security teams
Frequently touched surfaces in the church, chairs, pew tops, and doors, microphones etc. will be cleaned and sanitized per CDC recommendations after every liturgy.

AS WE PLAN TO REOPEN OUR CHURCH:

Dear Parishioners of St. Angela Merici Catholic Church, as we plan to reopen our church for public Mass and the celebration of Sacraments, we must ensure that

- Hygiene and sanitation are place
- Before you come to church take your body temperature and if it is beyond 100 please stay home
- If you have persistent cough, stay home
- If you Feel sick stay home.
- And when you come to church, please wear a face mask and hand gloves
- Maintain a safe distance
- Do not touch side doors as we shall ensure they will be wide open for your safety and those of parishioners.
- Only one door will serve as entrance and the stairway as exit
- Follow directions from ushers who will show you where to stand or seat during mass or the celebration of sacraments
- Members of a particular family must seat together
- No embracing, hugs or kisses during the sign of peace

- No Hymnals or papers.
- No paper bulletins except electronically on the website

Weekly.

- Priests will come straight from the Sacristy to the altar at the beginning of Mass and head back to the sacristy without mingling with the congregation soon after it is over.
- Reception of communion is on the hand and not directly at the tongue.
- Should a priest accidentally touch someone's hand he will immediately use a hand sanitizer
- Maintain a safe distance during reception of Holy Communion
- Remove your mask as you approach priest to receive communion on your hand, put it in your mouth and place your mask once again.
- Offering will be placed in safe wooden boxes and not in baskets as before, we encourage electronic giving on line After the final blessing, head straight to your car or home, no group\devotional group meetings in the church buildings.
- Priest will not impose or touch head of anyone for a blessing.

ORACION A SAN MIGUEL ARCANGEL: San Miguel Arcángel, defiéndenos en la batalla. Se nuestro amparo contra la perversidad y asechanzas del demonio. Reprímale, Dios, pedimos suplicantes, y tu príncipe de la Milicia Celestial, arroja al infierno con el divino poder a Satanás y a los otros espíritus malignos que andan dispersos por el mundo para la perdición de las alma.

Reflexión

Haciendo eco de la queja escuchada en las lecturas de la semana pasada, la Primera Lectura de hoy presenta nuevamente protestas de que Dios no es justo. ¿Por qué castiga con la muerte al que comienza en la virtud pero cae en la iniquidad, mientras da vida al inicuo que se aparta del pecado? Esta es la pregunta que Jesús aborda en la parábola del Evangelio de hoy.

El primer hijo representa a los pecadores más atroces de la época de Jesús, recaudadores de impuestos y prostitutas, que por su pecado al principio se negaron a servir en la viña del Señor, el reino. Ante la predicación de Juan el Bautista, se arrepintieron e hicieron lo correcto y justo. El segundo hijo representa a los líderes de Israel, quienes dijeron que servirían a

Dios en la viña, pero se negaron a creerle a Juan cuando les dijo que debían producir buenos frutos como evidencia de su arrepentimiento.

Una vez más, las lecturas de esta semana nos invitan a reflexionar sobre los caminos insondables de la justicia y la misericordia de Dios. Él enseña Sus caminos solo a los humildes, como cantamos en el Salmo de hoy. Y en la epístola de hoy, Pablo presenta a Jesús como el modelo de esa humildad por la cual llegamos a conocer el verdadero camino de la vida.

Pablo canta un hermoso himno a la Encarnación. A diferencia de Adán, el primer hombre, que en su orgullo se aferró a ser Dios, el Nuevo Adán, Jesús, se humilló a sí mismo para convertirse en un esclavo, obediente hasta la muerte de cruz. En esto, Él ha mostrado a los pecadores, a cada uno de nosotros, el camino de regreso al Padre. Solo podemos acercarnos a Dios para servir en Su viña, la Iglesia, teniendo esa misma actitud que Cristo.

Esto es lo que les faltaba a los líderes de Israel. En su vanagloria, presumieron su superioridad, que ya no tenían necesidad de escuchar la Palabra de Dios o escuchar a los siervos de Dios.

Pero este es el camino a la muerte, como Dios le dice a Ezequiel hoy. Siempre debemos vaciarnos de nosotros mismos, buscar el perdón de nuestros pecados y debilidades, confesar de rodillas que Él es el Señor, para la gloria del Padre.

Reflection

Echoing the complaint heard in last week's readings, today's First Reading again presents protests that God isn't fair. Why does He punish with death one who begins in virtue but falls into iniquity, while granting life to the wicked one who turns from sin? This is the question that Jesus takes up in the parable in today's Gospel.

The first son represents the most heinous sinners of Jesus' day—tax collectors and prostitutes—who by their sin at first refused to serve in the Lord's vineyard, the kingdom. At the preaching of John the Baptist, they repented and did what was right and just. The second son represents Israel's leaders—who said they would serve God in the vineyard, but refused to believe John when he told them they must produce good fruits as evidence of their repentance.

Once again, this week's readings invite us to ponder the unfathomable ways of God's justice and mercy. He teaches His ways only to the humble, as we sing in today's Psalm. And in the Epistle today, Paul presents Jesus as the model of that humility by which we come to know life's true path.

Paul sings a beautiful hymn to the Incarnation. Unlike Adam, the first man, who in his pride grasped at being God, the New Adam, Jesus, humbled himself to become a slave, obedient even unto death on the cross. In this He has shown sinners—each one of us—the way back to the Father. We can only come to God to serve in His vineyard, the Church, by having that same attitude as Christ.

This is what Israel's leaders lacked. In their vainglory, they presumed their superiority—that they had no further need to hear God's Word or listen to God's servants.

But this is the way to death, as God tells Ezekiel today. We are always to be emptying ourselves, seeking forgiveness for our sins and frailties, confessing on bended knee that He is Lord, to the glory of the Father.
