SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Sponsor Certificates are often required before one can serve as a Godparent for the Sacrament of Baptism or as a Sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation. In order to receive a Sponsor Certificate from Holy Rosary Parish, one needs to be a registered parishioner of the Parish, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, be over the age of 14 and if married, must have a valid Church marriage (married by a Priest or Deacon in a church) as well as be a practicing Catholic who attends Sunday Mass.

As proof of the above, the person is required to present a copy of their Certificate of Confirmation when requesting the Sponsor Certificate.

Holy Rosary can only give Sponsor Certificates to parishioners living within the parish boundaries. We cannot issue a certificate to those who receive their Sacraments here, but now live out of state or out of the parish. The certificate must be given by the parish in which the party is currently living and registered.

Sponsor Certificates may be obtained only after one of the Sunday Masses. The person seeking the certificate must speak with one of the priests after Mass and request one.
