

Confirmation Preparation

REQUIREMENTS



Attend weekly Confirmation meetings. We will meet on alternating Sunday evenings after 5:30 Mass from 6:45-9:00 in the Youth Room.

Select a sponsor. A sponsor walks with you on your journey to Confirmation. They can be anyone 16 years old and above who has been confirmed. Select your sponsor by December 14th, 2025.



Research a Saint and present your trifold board at our Saint fair on November 9th. Select your Confirmation Saint by April 19th, 2026.

Serve others. We require that you fill out a service form for three service projects: two in the parish, and one in the community. This shows us that you've at least given service a try, but we hope that you'll serve others regularly!



Attend a retreat. Our Confirmation retreat will be November 21st-23rd. If you cannot attend this retreat, please find another retreat to attend!

Write a letter to the Bishop. You and your sponsor will write a letter to Bishop Boyea sharing with him what you have done to prepare for Confirmation and why you desire to be Confirmed in the Catholic Faith.



Interview with Fr. John, one of our Deacons, or Confirmation leaders. We will wrap up the year of Confirmation preparation with a 15 minute one-on-one interview.

The Precepts of the Church

Requirements for Practicing Catholics

The precepts of the Church are set in the context of a moral life bound to and nourished by liturgical life. The obligatory character of these positive laws decreed by the pastoral authorities is meant to guarantee to the faithful the indispensable minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth in love of God and neighbor. (CCC 2041)

- Attend Mass and rest from work on Sundays and holy days of obligation.
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year.
- Receive the Eucharist at least during the Easter Season.
- Observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence.
- Provide for the material needs of the Church, each according to his abilities. (CCC 2042-2043)
