

Parent/Guardian's Expectation Agreement 2025-2026

At my child's Baptism, I agreed, with faith in God's assistance, "to bring him/her up in the practice of the Catholic Faith." (Rite of Baptism for Children).

- As my son or daughter begins preparation to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation, I recognize my continued responsibility for guiding him/her in the practice of the faith.
- With the help of the parish community at St. Andrew, it is my desire to remain faithful to my responsibilities by being involved in my child's preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation at St. Andrew Catholic Church.
- I acknowledge, in faith, that the Sacrament of Confirmation is a gift from God entrusted to the Church.
- I further acknowledge that the Sacrament of Confirmation bestows the fullness of God's Spirit initially given at Baptism, fully initiating one into the Catholic Church.

I have been informed of the requirements expected of me as a parent/guardian of a Confirmation candidate:

- To help my son or daughter attend Sunday Mass and Confirmation Prep each week
- To provide necessary support to complete projects and assignments
- To contact Monica Hubbard as soon as possible when additional support is needed

I agree to encourage my son or daughter to freely and willingly engage in the process of Sacramental Preparation for Confirmation offered at St. Andrew.

I recognize my son or daughter must freely and willingly choose to accept for himself or herself the grace that comes from the Sacrament of Confirmation.

I also recognize that at any time, my child may remove himself/herself from the process of preparation if he/she does not feel ready or willing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

I further acknowledge that my son or daughter's failure to participate in the Confirmation program at St. Andrew *may* delay his or her ability to receive the Sacrament at the Spring Confirmation Mass in Spring 2026.
