### **ArchNY Youth Team**

The ArchNY Youth Team is a team of 20 youth in grades 9-12 from the various counties of the Archdiocese of New York, which comes together for ongoing faith and leadership formation as well as collaboration with the Office of Youth Ministry to meet the needs of and to empower young people in the Archdiocese of New York by:

- assisting in interpreting the needs of youth and advocating for their concerns to the members of Archdiocesan leadership;
- representing the youth of the archdiocese as servant leaders in various capacities;
- drawing young people to responsible participation in the life, mission, and works in the faithful community of the People of God;
- developing and forming the members of the team in leadership skills which will equip them to be servant leaders in their home parish ministries;
- raising up Catholic leaders in the archdiocese through the team's involvement in the development of programs for youth; and
- empowering its members to encourage the spiritual and personal growth of their peers by facilitating active participation of youth in archdiocesan events.

#### **Application Requirements and Procedures**

- 1. ArchNY Youth Team application and recommendations from the pastor and youth minister/adult youth leader are **due by April 29, 2019.** No candidate can be discerned without all the required recommendations.
