I thank God for the wonderful care that I have received. I feel truly blessed. I know that my life has been changed and I will always have vestiges of the disease but I can say that I have made it this far and will continue to cherish what I have.

In a few weeks, I will have a PET Scan which will tell us if I am cancer free. I thank God for the gift of life."


