

Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

Happy Mother's Day to all the Mothers of the parish! May your day be blessed with happiness and peace as your special role is celebrated. Today we give thanks for all the ways in which mothers nurture and love their children. We also give thanks for our own mothers, whether they are still with us or have gone before us in faith, we should be thankful for all the ways in which they have given of themselves for the sake of their children. Let us always be thankful for a mothers love! Again, Happy Mother's Day!

In the Gospel today, Jesus makes the declaration that his sheep hear His voice. Jesus also says that because they hear his voice, they follow Him. Some people do not appreciate being referred to as sheep, if that is the case; simply substitute the word disciples for sheep. Jesus was not intending to diminish the worth of anyone in the statement; He simply was using terms that were common to the people of the time. The more important matter for us is ascertaining whether we hear Jesus' voice or not. There are many different voices attempting to drown out the voice of the one who desperately desires that we follow Him. There are the loud voices of commercialism that want us to hear the messages that promise to lead us to happiness. There are the terrifying voices that attempt to spread fear. There are the sad voices that remind us of the amount of suffering that exists in our world. There are the quiet voices of individualism that whisper to us that everything is acceptable and will not harm anyone. We hear the seductive voices of greed, power and glory that attempt to seduce us to act only for our own benefit. Then, there is the calm, reassuring, inspiring voice of Jesus simply inviting us to follow. All of the voices have the same goal; they want us to hear a promise of helping us to discover what we long for in our hearts – happiness. Every voice that is not speaking some part of the Good News, every voice that is not promoting a healthy understanding of God's love will never lead us to happiness. At times, we may have to strain our ears in order to hear Him, but may we never give up trying to hear the voice of Jesus. Jesus knows us and knows what we yearn for and will never give up calling our names.

REGISTRATION FOR RETURNING STUDENTS

Religious Education Classes for this year will conclude on May 21. Registration forms for the registration of returning students for our Parish Religious Education Program will be sent home with the oldest child during the week of May 20. Completed forms may be returned on May 22. (registration forms will not be accepted until May 22).

REGISTRATION FORMS FOR NEW STUDENTS -

those entering 1st grade or transferring from another Religious Education Program – will be available in Church on the weekend of May 25/26. You will need a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate and for those transferring from another Parish – a record of grades completed from the former parish.

The following applies to all registrations, new and returning students:

Classes will be offered on Mondays and Tuesdays at 4:30 PM and 6:30 PM. Classes on a particular day may fill up for some grades/sessions. There will be plenty of room for all the children but each class does have a limit to the number of children in the class. So please return the registration forms as soon as possible – once a particular class has been filled, no more students will be placed in that class. There are **no exceptions** to this policy in order to be fair to all families. If a class is filled, students will be placed in a class/session that has space. Registrations will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. Thanks!

Confessions: After the 5:00 PM Mass on Saturday or by appointment.

<u>BAPTISM</u> – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

<u>Marriage</u> – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

<u>Sick Calls</u> – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

<u>Registration</u> – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

<u>Sponsor Certificates</u> – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
