Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

On hearing of the death of John the Baptist, Jesus was understandably upset and in need of a quiet place to deal with his grief. However, when he stepped ashore, there were already many people waiting for him. He began to teach, nourish and heal without hesitation. The day wore on and evening approached leaving the people without food for a long period of time. Jesus satisfied their hunger with a miraculous event, a marvelous happening and a pointer to the fact that God, who creates the world, provides us with food and takes care of our every need. The people returned to their homes satisfied and spiritually refreshed from the time they spent in the company of Jesus.

The method that Jesus chose in getting food to the people should get our attention. Jesus chose to accomplish this great task not by himself, but with the help of his disciples who were reluctant to accept any responsibility to provide food for the hungry crowd. The first impulse of the disciples was to send the people away to fend for themselves – let someone else deal with the problem. Challenged by Jesus to use their own resources, they came up with several loaves of bread and a couple of fish. The little they had, when placed in the hands of Jesus, turned out to be enough. The meager amount of bread and fish are symbols of the power for goodness which we all possess. According to human calculations, it may seem of little account, but it is what the Lord has given us and expects that we will use in service to God. The gifts we are called to offer may be the ability to be a good neighbor, a caring and empathetic listener or a willing member of a group that works to help others. In whatever way we minister to the needs of others, we show the compassion of Christ. Like the disciples, we take what we have, place it in the hands of Jesus and hand it out generously to the one who needs it.

On their own, our efforts may seem small and insignificant, but when we place them in God's hands, they become part of God's great saving mission and offer deeper meaning to our lives. We must always remember that God does not bless us in a vacuum. God blesses us so that we can, in a very diversified way, be a blessing to someone else.

REGISTRATION FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Plans are moving right along for our annual golf outing that will take place on September 17th at the Forsgate Country Club in Monroe. Once again this year the outing will utilize the Banks Course. The historic Banks Course was designed by Charles H. Banks, one of America's celebrated "Golden Age" architects. Regarded as an architectural gem, the "traditional" design of the Banks Course features many holes inspired by some of the legendary Scottish courses, as well as Bank's signature steep and dramatic greenside bunkers. SUNDAY MASS – The public celebration of Sunday Mass has resumed with limited seating capacity. Sunday Mass is celebrated on Saturday evening at 5:00 PM and Sunday morning at 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. We may only have one-third of the capacity in the Church. Please remember that masks must be worn and cover mouth and nose. Also, doors are locked at the start of Mass so that there is no need for people to wander around looking for a seat – so please arrive before Mass begins. DISPENSATION FROM ATTENDING MASS

The Bishop of our Diocese had originally issued a dispensation from attending Mass that was to remain in effect until the beginning of September. That dispensation has now been extended until further notice. The faithful are certainly encouraged but not required to attend Sunday Mass in their parishes whenever possible or to participate in live-streamed parish Masses offered online until the dispensation ceases. Those at the greatest risk of illness are advised to stay away from groups. We are doing everything we can to keep people safe so that the public celebration of Mass may continue. Let's keep praying.

DAILY MASS

We have resumed the public gathering for Mass at 9:00 AM on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday with no more than 50 people. Mass will also be live streamed at 9:00 AM on those days. You will be able to participate in real time from your home by going to <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UClImH-Un3j9sUCCqg-KYoSg/live>. If you miss the live stream, it will be recorded and available to watch. It does take a little time for the recording to process, so it will be available as soon as possible.

We will use Flocknotes to let parents know if Religious Education classes are canceled and we send out reminders about scheduled closings for holidays, etc. It is easy to be on the notification list – just text the code sjmill to 84576 and follow the prompts. You may also go to our website to be included – stjosephmillstone.org/flocknotes. Just enter your information and follow the prompts. You can then select the groups that you want information from. You can choose to receive the weekly bulletin or be notified if someone in the parish needs help or be notified when someone has asked for prayers or be part of special programs like the Lenten Program listed in the bulletin on the previous page and more. For those with children in the Religious Education Program, you must choose the class and session that you have a child attending. If you have a child in grade 3 and a child in grade 7 on Tuesday at 6:30PM, you would choose Tuesday 6:30PM grade 3 and Tuesday 6:30PM grade 7. **If you are not signed up on Flocknotes, you will not receive notification about closings.** Please remember to use contact information (cell number and email) that you use regularly. All information is confidential. Others are not able to view your information. Please remember that email and text message will be sent from Flocknotes. Thanks!

BAPTISM – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

Marriage – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

Sick Calls – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

Registration – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

Sponsor Certificates – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
