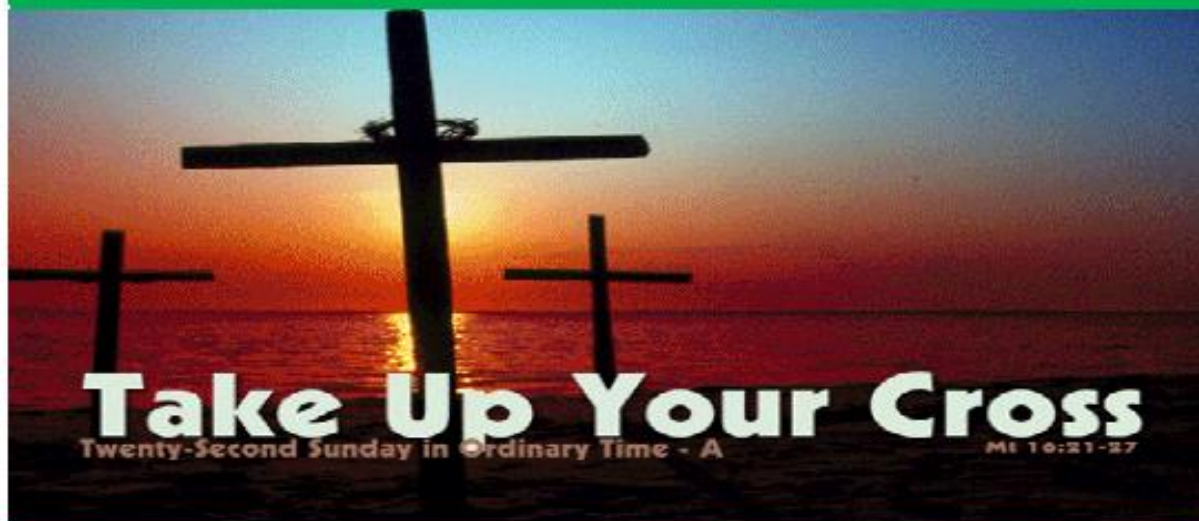

Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

Peter found it very challenging to accept that the mission of Jesus would end with crucifixion and death. Understanding why pain and suffering were necessary for discipleship was more beyond his comprehension at the point we hear about in the Gospel today. Peter wanted Jesus to avoid the course of action that Jesus described. Like many of the people of his time, and many people in our own time for that matter, he failed to grasp how suffering could play any role in God's plan. Peter continued to hold on to the belief that being part of God's kingdom meant power and success. Even though Peter had proclaimed Jesus as the Messiah, he had not let go of the idea of a Messiah of earthly splendor and glory. Peter would have to struggle and even experience complete failure before accepting the fact that the standards of Christ were not those of prosperity and privilege. Jesus cautioned Peter about being closed minded about God's plan. In very stern words, Jesus informed Peter that God did not adhere to the standards of the world. Jesus' response to Peter included the warning that when we hold on to worldly ways, we lose our ability to benefit from God's ways.

The message in the Gospel passage today are not meant solely for Peter. They are intended to challenge us to make the choice to follow God's ways or the world ways because it is impossible to do both. Many would prefer a Gospel message of prosperity, power and privilege. The fact is, this is not reality. The real reality is that we cannot escape pain and suffering because we all encounter it in one way or another – sickness, failed relationships, loss of Job, financial struggles, the death of a loved one. In those moments we must choose to trust in the way of Jesus and follow the cross across the hill of Calvary or turn bitter because our expectations were not met. Being a Christian is a demanding honor because God's way of doing things is contrary to human expectations. A willingness to follow Jesus, even with our crosses will lead us to true glory, honor and joy. When we refuse to allow our expectations and the ways of the world to rule our hearts, we will come to understand that we have found real glory that will last forever.

You can choose to receive the weekly bulletin or be notified if someone in the parish needs help or be notified when someone has asked for prayers or be part of special programs like the Lenten Program listed in the bulletin on the previous page and more. For those with children in the Religious Education Program, you must choose the class and session that you have a child attending. If you have a child in grade 3 and a child in grade 7 on Tuesday at 6:30PM, you would choose Tuesday 6:30PM grade 3 and Tuesday 6:30PM grade 7. **If you are not signed up on Flocknotes, you will not receive notification about closings.** Please remember to use contact information (cell number and email) that you use regularly. All information is confidential. Others are not able to view your information. Please remember that email and text message will be sent from Flocknotes. Thanks!

BAPTISM – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

Marriage – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

Sick Calls – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

Registration – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

Sponsor Certificates – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
