Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

Sometimes, even with good intentions, we can obscure the meaning of anything that we become overly familiar with. The thanksgiving hymn of Mary in the Gospel today is one such example. We refer to this hymn of thanksgiving as the Magnificat. Familiarity with the hymn has caused some to react to it in an overly spiritualized way. What we refer to as the Magnificat is modeled on Hannah's Song in the 1<sup>st</sup> Book of Samuel (chapt. 2 versus 1-10). Some of the lines of the Magnificat are direct quotations from Hannah's Song. Mary spoke the song of thanksgiving when her cousin Elizabeth called Mary blessed for her trust in God and believing that God's word would be fulfilled.

Careful attention to the words and world views of that time show that the Magnificat is not only a hymn of thanksgiving, but also a revolutionary song. Later on, the Beatitudes spoken by Jesus contain what could only have been viewed as revolutionary beliefs. The Magnificat and the Beatitudes are related to one another in that they both are proclamations of revolutionary social vision. They turn the accepted social values of their time, and most times for that matter, upside down. The powerful would not take kindly to promoting a belief that the arrogant would be scattered, the rulers would be thrown down, the lowly would be raised up, the hungry would be filled and the rich lose everything. Especially in a time when free speech was not a thing and status was promoted as being blessed by God, these were and are revolutionary lines. The sentiments and the values that Hannah's Song, Mary's Magnificat and the Beatitudes still hold a promise for us today, if we allow them to do so without diminishing the force of the statements by overly spiritualizing them or privatizing them so that they become just nice poetry or sentimental prayer. We must never rob Hannah's Song, The Magnificat or the Beatitudes of the social context out of which they sprang and what they preached as being against the ways of God. If Hannah or Mary or even Jesus spoke the exact words today, they would be dismissed as promoting socialism. However, all three individuals – Hannah, Mary and Jesus – spoke bold words to promote trust in God. Ultimately God will win. Those who heed and adopt the words of those who spoke such revolutionary thoughts, will know that they made the right choice to have complete trust in God.

## **LIFTING OF THE DISPENSATION FROM ATTENDING MASS IN PERSON**

The Bishops of the five Dioceses of New Jersey have announced that the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation that has been in place during the pandemic will be lifted as of June 5, 2021. The following is the announcement from the Bishops: *“At this time, due to the observance of public safety protocols and the increase in the availability of vaccines, we have begun a return to some sense of normalcy in various sectors of our society. Therefore, we the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation beginning on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and Sunday, June 6, 2021, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We welcome the Christian faithful to return to the regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law canon 1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180). This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult the local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (canon 87). Finally, safety protocols (such as wearing masks, social distancing, etc.) and liturgical directives in each New Jersey Diocese remains in place until modified or revoked by the respective Diocesan Bishop.”*

## **COVID19 RESTRICTIONS UPDATE**

### **MASS RELATED POLICIES**

- Masks are optional. Anyone may wear a mask for safety or peace of mind. Those who are not vaccinated and children under 12 are strongly advised to wear a mask indoors for both their safety and the safety of others.
- The cry room and the loft will remain closed at the present time.
- Out of an abundance of caution, the Presentation of the gifts of Bread and Wine will still be omitted.
- We will continue to use a basket at the back of the church for offertory donations instead of passing the basket around.
- The Sign of Peace will continue to be exchanged by a wave or nod with the greeting of Peace be with you.
- At the time of Communion, everyone will come forward to receive. It is advised to leave space between families/individuals of different households.
- Communion will be offered only in the hand.
- Priest/Deacon/Eucharistic Ministers will sanitize hands and wear a mask for the distribution of Communion.

### **NONE MASS RELATED POLICIES**

- Groups and Ministries may now resume meetings. Masks are not mandated, however the CDC guidelines for those who are not vaccinated should be observed. Anyone who is more comfortable with a mask, is free to do so.
- Handouts at meetings may be used.
- Food/beverages may be offered but great care should be exercised with the handling of food.

**BAPTISM** – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

**Marriage** – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

**Sponsor Certificates** – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
