Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

The Feast of the Holy Trinity, which we celebrate today, is the celebration of the mystery of God as a family of love. It reminds us that we have not been left in the dark in our struggle to attempt to understand God. From what Jesus said and did on earth, we can grasp little pieces of the innermost being of the mystery of God. Throughout his life, Jesus was constantly talking about God as his Father, and he referred to himself as God's only Son. Jesus explained also that his mission was to do the will of the Father. Jesus also introduced us to the Spirit whom Jesus talks about as being a real person, completely different from the Son and Father. The Spirit's purpose is to inspire people to continue the work begun by Jesus and everyone into the love of God the Father.

This Feast reminds of an important truth that we should never forget – God's plan is that we share in God's life and glory. By our Baptism we are raised to the level at which we become sharers in the family of God. We are born of God the father, God the Son becomes our brother and the love of God is poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit. This revelation of God's inner life of three persons, in which we have a share, is one of God's greatest gifts to us and it is the model towards which all of us should aim and strive to live by.

Jesus reveals the mystery of the Trinity not just to let us know the truth about God, but also to know the truth about ourselves as far as our origin, where our destiny lies and how we can arrive at that final point. We only exist, and the world only exists, because God gives life. God is the Father who looks upon us as children of God and is closer to us than we even are to ourselves. Every day is a day to love the Father, follow the example of Jesus and open our hearts to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Even though the fullest understanding of one God, three persons may be elusive to our human minds, we should do our best to allow the Holy Trinity to be a practical part of our lives. Love is the binding force of the Three Persons of the Trinity, so when we love we share in the community of love which is the living God.

This celebration of the abundance of God's love is a great time for appreciating what God has done and continues to do for us.


## **FOOD COLLECTION**

**BAPTISM** – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

**Marriage** – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

**Sick Calls** – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

**Registration** – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

**Sponsor Certificates** – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
