Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

The call and the cost of Christian commitment are emphasized in the Gospel passage for today where the life of discipleship and its qualities are laid out before us. There is nothing about being a follower of Jesus that does not demand effort. Discipleship is not something to be entered into casually because all existing responsibilities have to second place to being a discipol of Jesus. On his journey to Jerusalem, Jesus meets three individuals who claim to be anxious to follow Jesus were completely unprepared for the challenge involved. The young man who was bursting with enthusiasm vowed to be a follower wherever it would call him to go must have been greatly surprised to hear Jesus dampen his spirits and warn him off with the caution that the Son of Man did not even have a home to call his own. Jesus was only being fair when he made it very clear what is expected of those who wish to be a disciple. If we want to accompany Jesus we must know what we are doing and be aware of the harsh realities of living the life as a follower of Christ. The message to us is just as demanding as it was to that young man who had such enthusiasm – if anything stands in our way or takes priority over Jesus in our lives, then we are not free to follow him.

A half-hearted response to the call to discipleship will never give us the opportunity to experience the kind of growth that will really benefit us individually or collectively. For some, the busyness of life gets in the way, for others misguided devotion to ideologies prevent to allegiance to Jesus and for others, the fear of eliminating the things that are contrary to the message of Jesus stands as an obstacle to real discipleship.

Discipleship means living the life and exhibiting the qualities that we guide us to a deepening relationship with God. We cannot simply fit this in when it is convenient or when we are done with all the important business of life. Discipleship must be a seamless part of our life that dictates all the other actions that we do. Discipleship must have priority over our status, our popularity and all the other goals we set for ourselves. Let us pray for the grace we need in order to willingly follow Christ wholeheartedly.

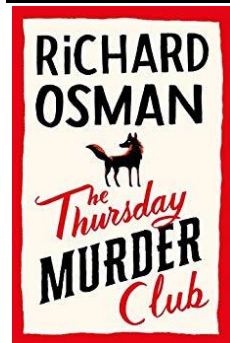

BAPTISM – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

Marriage – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

Sick Calls – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

Registration – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

Sponsor Certificates – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
