Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends.

Jesus sent his disciples ahead of him to announce, with a message of peace, that the reign of God was at hand. We are told in the Gospel passage from Luke that the disciples returned with a great sense of joy that the mission had been successful as evident by the people who flocked to listen and welcome the Word of God. It is very heartening to be reminded of the enthusiasm that was present at that time in both those who spoke the Word and God and those who heard it. At the same time. Jesus appears to lament over the fact that there would be far fewer people who would be willing to proclaim the Word of God than there were those who were ready to receive it. – "the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few." Even in the time of Jesus, there were relatively few people who were willing to take the bold step of proclaiming God's Word. It was and is safer to be a spectator. It was and is much less risky to hear than it is to be the messenger.

The need to spread the Word of God continues to be real while those who are willing to be the ones proclaiming God's Word remains few. The invitation to take part in the work of the Lord is extended to our generation, to our present day and age. Our mission as Christians continues to the task of bringing the peace of Christ wherever we go and to all we meet. No special training is needed for the work that Jesus has entrusted to us. What is required is the willingness to take God's Word and proclaim it unfiltered by our own desires, prejudices and ideologies that we have allowed into our lives. One of the greatest hindrances to the spreading of God's Word is the way in which God's Word has been corrupted to support human desire and subscribed ideologies. Too often God's Word is made into the supporting message for human endeavors instead of allowing God's Word to direct all that we do.

The joy of the disciples, after proclaiming the Good News, was real. The enthusiasm of the people who heard the Good News was authentic. The message of peace that Jesus sent lead to the conversion of many hearts. Our joy and the joy we offer can be just as genuine when we accept the Good News of Jesus.


#### **FOOD COLLECTION**

Confessions: At this time, Confessions are Offered by appointment only.

<u>BAPTISM</u> – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

<u>Marriage</u> – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

<u>Sick Calls</u> – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

<u>Registration</u> – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

<u>Sponsor Certificates</u> – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.


