Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

In light of what Jesus says concerning wealth in the Gospel passage this week, it would be wise to take some time to think and pray about our attitude toward material possessions. When we get right down to it, the Gospel is warning us against making money or accumulating possessions the goal of our existence. Money does play an important role in our daily lives and it deeply influences us, whether we have it or not. It is extremely easy to allow money to be our guiding force because we learn at an early age that money talks, it opens doors and is a voice that is heard. The place that money holds in our daily existence actually demonstrates that values in our world are out of focus. No one is immune to the lure that money can have in our lives. Given the emphasis that society places on money, it is difficult to remain indifferent to its power. Money is something we have to use but, at the same time, as people of faith, we must watch in case it gets a grip on us and destroys us by becoming our god. Money is so seductive that we can easily find ourselves in its grip.

The saying, 'money is the root of all evil,' does contain a certain element of truth but is too simplistic to simply adopt as our mantra because money is also the means of doing much good. So what are we to do? The best thing we can do is to honestly evaluate our attitude toward money. Does money dominate our lives? If so, we must try to refocus because allowing it to be the dominating force in our lives we may easily forget the goal of life's destiny. When money, or the accumulation of possessions, becomes our driving force, our values become muddled and our Christian commitment to God may be drained of all its strength. Greed creeps into our hearts, deadens our conscience and dulls our sense of responsibility to make the world better.

This Gospel challenges us to discover whether God is taking first place in our lives or if we have allowed something else to priority. Jesus helps us to learn that our longing for happiness and security will never be satisfied by created things. Remaining on the right path we lead us to true riches.


## BISHOP'S ANNIVERSARY BLESSING

**BAPTISM** – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

**Marriage** – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

**Sick Calls** – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

**Registration** – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

**Sponsor Certificates** – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
