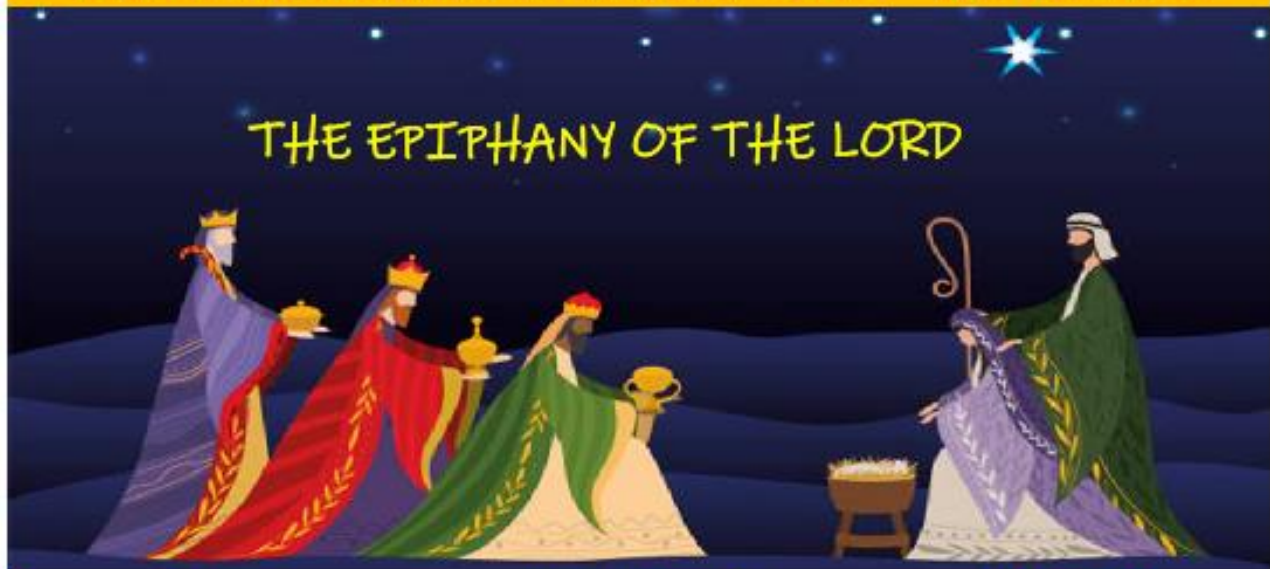

Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

Our Gospel tells us that God chose to be engaged with humankind. This gospel is the story of our journey to God. Like the Magi, we are often called to God from far off places, distances often of our own making. Like the Magi, we often make our way through indifference, hostility, politics, even scandal...and then we find the one we are to worship. We have tamed this story with talk of kings, crowns, and camels. We often forget it is about real people seeking someone, seeking the light, that we all hope to find.

What we find is inclusiveness. The whole Christmas story is about inclusiveness. The first to come to the stable were shepherds, not as we see them on Christmas cards, but real shepherds who were looked down upon and avoided. They were chosen to be the first to hear that God had touched earth. Then the Magi, outsiders, pagans, who would be avoided because they were ritually impure. So the two groups who were invited and guided to the stable were among the most rejected.

Isn't that what the gospel is all about? We find Jesus most of the time with the most rejected. That is why our church must be attentive to people whose lives have been fractured, people who turn away from our church, people who are not accepted. The Eucharist is not a reward for good behavior, it is food for the journey. What does all this tell us?

It tells us that if we have ever felt rejected, we belong at the stable. If we have somehow not measured up to other people's standards, we belong at the stable. If we have sinned or separated ourselves from God, we belong at the stable. It is interesting that when they had found the Lord, the Magi entered the stable, and not a word was spoken. Perhaps words could not convey all they had found. The One whom the whole universe cannot contain, now enclosed in a tiny baby.... they look, they believe. The only thing they could do was fall on their knees, and offer Him their gifts. They wanted to give Him something.

As the New Year progresses, I leave you with a question: As you come forward to receive Jesus today, what will you give Him? All He wants is your heart!

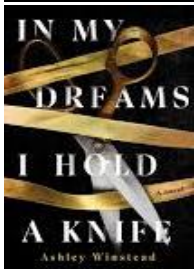
## FOOD COLLECTION

**BAPTISM** – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Parents are asked to register for a Baptism Preparation Session prior to the Baptism. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

**Marriage** – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

**Sick Calls** – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

**Registration** – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

**Sponsor Certificates** – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
