

Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

The preaching of Jesus is full of illustrations from the ordinary lives of the people of his time. Many were farmers and fishermen. By doing this, Jesus made his message relatable the people and demonstrated that their lives were important. There is one image though that seems to stand out from the rest of those used by Jesus and that is the image of Christ as the Good Shepherd. There is perhaps no better loved picture of Jesus than that of the Good Shepherd. In describing Himself as the Good Shepherd, Jesus was painting a beautiful picture of his loving care for the human family while emphasizing how special we are in the eyes of God. Each one of us has a special place in the heart of Jesus as he calls us by name and cares for us individually. Jesus is our constant guardian and guide who constantly calls us home when we are inclined to wander and stray from the path we are called to follow. Jesus' everlasting love never gives up on us and He keeps following us and calling out until we respond. More importantly, if we tune our ears to his voice, we will not stray because he will never let us down. There is no greater basis for hope that the truth that we are loved by God is such a wonderful manner.

The question for all of us to answer is what response are we making for the gift of God's loving care? In truth, the only response God seeks and that is worth making is to be alert and ready to answer when are called to come and follow Jesus. The compassion of Jesus is recognized in hearts that are full of tenderness and love. We need constant reminders that our calling is to be shepherded by Jesus so that we may respond confidently when we are called to make the presence of Christ known to others.

We make the presence of Christ known when we act as Jesus calls us to act. We can be the touch of human love for those who have no friends. The caring acts of God are performed in the hands that are willing to serve the needs of others. Christ is depending on each one of us to willingly choose the path that will allow us to be visual reminders of the saving action of the Good Shepherd.

FOOD COLLECTION



BAPTISM – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

Marriage – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

Sick Calls – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

Registration – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

Sponsor Certificates – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
