Dear Friends,

Saying farewell to a loved one is not easy and is something that we never fully grow accustomed to doing. Today we remember the Ascension of the Lord, which marks the end of Jesus' earthly mission and His glorious return to the Father. Jesus had achieved the work that He was sent to do. Perhaps trumpets were sounding in heaven to welcome the arrival of the ascending Lord, but most likely the disciples were experiencing a deep sadness in their hearts due to His departure. However, the disciples would not be given the opportunity to simply sit around in sadness because the final words of Jesus, "I am with you always. Go make disciples of all nations," while meant to bring comfort, were also extremely urgent in meaning. Not only was Jesus promising that He was not abandoning them, but Jesus also entrusted them with the mission of making the love of God the Father known. This mission would be carried out by the disciples through joyful and selfless lives in the service of others. In the absence of Jesus, the disciples could not remain inactive but had to be willing to move into the future with courage. The disciples were given a vital and essential role in announcing the salvation that Christ had gained on Calvary by transforming death into the dawn of new life. While Jesus would no longer be physically present, the disciples would be assisted by the Holy Spirit who would be their guide and strength as embarked on their new mission.

Today, we are called to ponder within our hearts the meaning of this great feast of the Ascension of the Lord so that we might grasp some of the confidence which God has placed in us. The Ascension focuses on what we must do to be with Christ forever. Where Jesus has gone, we hope to follow. Just like the early disciples, we are called to reveal God's love through our willingness to serve. We are entrusted with the work of those who have gone before us. We are called to help build up Christ's kingdom here on earth. In a world filled with challenges, doubts and fears we are called to proclaim the message that can turn sorrow into happiness by being those who demonstrate that we accepted the call of Christ.

BISHOP'S ANNIVERSARY BLESSING 2023



<u>BAPTISM</u> – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

<u>Marriage</u> – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

<u>Sick Calls</u> – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

<u>Registration</u> – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

<u>Sponsor Certificates</u> – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
