

Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

In spite of how far we have come in science, there is still much to learn. The one thing that has been made clear is that the magnitude and the mystery of creation is awesome. Even though it is possible to see 100 billion galaxies with powerful telescopes, who knows how many more galaxies are yet to be discovered? When we ponder the expanse of creation as people of faith, it should also reveal some hint as to the greatness and mystery of the Creator.

When people claim to understand God, or think they should be able to, they do not know God at all. Those who know God best are those who admit the great mystery that God is. God will always be too great for us to fully understand. Today we celebrate the mystery of the Trinity. Besides the fact that the Trinity is a great mystery, it took theologians several centuries to arrive at the concept. Historically it developed in an effort to understand precisely who Jesus is. Many heresies evolved in the course of trying to figure it all out. It was not until the Council of Nicaea in 325 that the church officially defined that Jesus is as much God as the Father is God.

There have been many attempts to better understand the Trinity and many examples are used to try to get a clearer picture. Some have compare the Trinity to a shamrock. Others used the image of God being a spring of water, the Sone as a river and the Holy Spirit as the sea. There is another comparison that identifies the Father as the root of a tree, the Son as the branches and the Holy Spirit as the fruit. Still others have held three matches, lit them and then joined them as a single flame. These examples might help us a little, but it is impossible to take the mystery out of the Trinity.

We can approach the Trinity only prayerfully and through the guidance of the Holy Spirit. In the Scriptures and in the quiet of our hearts we come to know that God our creator loves us, sent His Son to save us and is always present with us. We can try to put our faith into theological concepts, but it is in the experience of prayer that we will know the joy of being loved by the one God who expresses both a divine unity and a three-part diversity as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.



<u>BAPTISM</u> – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

<u>Marriage</u> – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

<u>Sick Calls</u> – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

<u>Registration</u> – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

<u>Sponsor Certificates</u> – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
