Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

Dear Friends,

It certainly seems that more and more there is a great indifference to the Gospel message so it is good to recall the instruction Jesus gave to his disciples as he prepared them for their mission of proclaiming the Good News. Jesus warned the disciples that opposition to the Gospel would be inevitable and prepares them for what lies ahead. Those who benefit from evil will never want to have the evil exposed and will act in an aggressive manner towards those who seek to do so. So the Gospel today is a reminder that we cannot expect everyone around us to receive the teaching of Christ with open arms. Jesus does not want his followers to be surprised that bearers of the Word of God may suffer rejection, hostility and ridicule. At the same time, Jesus helps his followers understand that the rejection must not prevent them from taking a stand for truth and justice, no matter how unpopular it may

Fear is an emotion that may easily cripple our lives and hinder us from being the people we want to be. There are many who live with the guilt of offering feeble and half-hearted responses in situations that provide an opportunity to give witness to our faith. The fear of being laughed at, ostracized or being regarded as weaklings is real and can easily cause someone to fail to stand up for what is just and right. Yet, we must be people who heed the words of Jesus. For evil to triumph, all that is required is for good people to remain silent. The pressure in the face of temptations to abandon our Christian principles because of ridicule arises often and challenges our loyalty to the teachings of Jesus.

The mission of Jesus was to proclaim His Father's love and Jesus never failed to carry out that responsibility. No one can be a true follower of Jesus without displaying an act of confidence in his work by announcing the message of the Kingdom of God. If the Word of God is to free us to act according to our deeper convictions, then we must pray for the grace to overcome our fears. There are many situations in life when it is good to remember the words to the Lord, "Fear not." Whatever happens, God is always in control.



Confessions: Confessions take place on Saturdays after the 5:00PM Mass or anytime by appointment.

<u>BAPTISM</u> – The Sacrament of Baptism is normally celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:30 PM. Baptisms must be scheduled in advance by calling the Parish Office. Sponsors must obtain Sponsor forms from their home parish – Sponsors must be active practicing Catholics. The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

<u>Marriage</u> – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

<u>Sick Calls</u> – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

<u>Registration</u> – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

<u>Sponsor Certificates</u> – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
