Some thoughts from Fr. Mike...

#### Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks words of profound comfort and promise to His disciples. As He prepares to leave them physically, He assures them—and us—of His ongoing presence and peace.

First, Jesus reminds us that love is not just a feeling—it's a commitment. "Whoever loves me will keep my word." True love for Christ is shown through our obedience to His teachings, especially the commandment to love one another. In a world that often equates love with sentiment or preference, Jesus calls us to a deeper, more enduring kind of love—one that bears fruit in action, fidelity, and sacrifice.

Then comes an astonishing promise: "We will come to him and make our dwelling with him." Imagine that—the Creator of the universe desires to make His home in us. This is not a distant God, but an intimate one. When we keep Christ's word, we become temples of the living God. Our very lives become sacred spaces where the divine presence abides.

Jesus then introduces the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who will teach and remind us of all He has said. The Spirit is not an occasional visitor but a permanent guide. In moments of doubt, confusion, or weakness, the Holy Spirit offers the truth, inspires us with courage, and strengthens us with grace. We are never alone; God's Spirit walks with us.

And finally, the gift of peace: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you." Not the fragile peace the world offers, which depends on circumstances, but a peace that abides even amid suffering and uncertainty. This peace flows from the trust that God is with us and working through all things.

In a world filled with anxiety and conflict, this peace is not only meant to give us comfort but also is a call to accept a mission. As bearers of Christ's peace, we are called to be peacemakers in our families, communities, and world.

So, let us ask: Do we keep His word—not only by hearing, but by living it? Do we welcome the Holy Spirit into our lives, letting God dwell within us? And do we carry the peace of Christ into the places that need it most?

The promise Jesus' makes in the Gospel today is not only for comfort but for transformation. May we open our hearts to Him, that He may truly make His dwelling within us.

The Sacrament of Baptism is not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

<u>Marriage</u> – Diocesan policy requires that arrangements for Marriage be made one (1) year in advance of the wedding. Refer any questions to the Pastor.

<u>Sick Calls</u> – Please contact the Parish Office when someone is seriously ill requiring a visit by a Priest. If someone is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis and would like to receive Communion please call the Parish Office

<u>Registration</u> – We are glad you are here and want you to feel like a full member of the parish. Registering as a parishioner helps us to know who you are and to stay in touch. Registration is required for sponsor forms.

<u>Sponsor Certificates</u> – This is a form required to be a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation. To receive a form, the following is required: -Be a registered, active (attends Mass) member of the parish (for at least 6 months); be at least 16 years of age; must have completed the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation; If married, have a valid marriage within the Church.
