WE PRAY - EASTER

Our Church is now more alive, brighter, and more festive than at any other time during the year. Flowers, colorful banners, and aromas delight and fill our senses. The Paschal Candle, prominent for 50 days, radiates light to the whole church. Our bells ring out, the waters of Baptism flow once again and well up with life. At Mass we process, led by the New Creation Cross of our Risen Savior. We sing of God's Majesty, "Glory to God, Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to people of Good will." Our response to the Scripture Reading (the Acts of the Apostles during the Season), is Psalm 66, "Lift up your hearts to the Lord, praise God's gracious mercy! Sing out your joy to the Lord, whose love is enduring." Our Alleluia is now sung before the Gospel. We profess our faith in response to the Creedal Questions; the sprinkled waters call to mind our common baptism. During our Eucharistic Prayer at the Lord's Table, we proclaim that it is through Jesus' Cross and Resurrection that we are set free to live the mystery of our faith. At the end of Mass, we are sent forth to be Jesus' disciples to the world...Alleluia. May our joy be a sign of Heaven's love for all people.
