Sourth Sunday of Advent



Light the fourth candle on your Advent wreath. In this final week of preparation for the birth of Jesus, reflect on the beauty and fragility of human life that we see in the infant Christ. Even when people are small, weak, defenseless, dependent, demanding or disgusting by worldly standards, God sees beauty. So should we see this beauty in ourselves and in others. 
