





Welcome to St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church! This is a very exciting time for our growing parish, and we are thrilled that you have decided to join us today.

Our parish was established in February 2015, by **The Most Reverend Michael F. Olson, Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Fort Worth,** to serve the rapidly-growing areas of Frisco, Little Elm, and Prosper in eastern Denton County, Texas.

Bishop Olson appointed **Rev. Richard Kirkham** as the first Pastor of the parish. The first mass of St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church was celebrated on February 8, 2015, at Purefoy Elementary in Frisco. The Diocese of Fort Worth purchased 52 acres in Prosper on March 4, 2015, upon which St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church and St. Martin de Porres Catholic School was to be built. In June 2015, all masses were moved to the St. Martin de Porres Catholic School building, located at 303 King Road in Frisco. The last mass at that location was celebrated on Monday, December 11, 2017.






