Welcome, Fr. Stephen! Pastor, St. Martin de Porres

Fr. Stephen Hauck was born in 1981 to Gerald and Vicki Hauck, and is 36 years old. He is the fifth of six children. He was ordained a deacon in April of 2016, and a priest in May of 2017 by Bishop Michael Olson for the service of the people of God in the Diocese of Ft. Worth. He attended Holy Trinity Seminary and the University of Dallas for studies, and St. Joseph Seminary and College in Covington, Louisiana and St. Mary's Seminary and the University of St. Thomas in Houston. His first assignment as a priest in the Diocese of Ft. Worth was at St. Michael Parish in Bedford until joining us here at St. Martin de Porres on July 1.

Fr. Stephen was raised Catholic, and moved frequently since his father was in the U.S. Army. When his father retired from the military in 1996, his family returned home to Arlington, Texas. After attending Nolan Catholic High School for two years, Fr. Stephen switched to Lamar High School in Arlington and graduated in 2000. Prior to seminary, Fr. Stephen worked full-time as a Computer Programmer and Quality Control Supervisor for a large wood distribution and manufacturing company in south Dallas.

Fr. Stephen has many hobbies including the Dallas Cowboys, Texas Rangers, fishing, shooting, BBQ, and cooking. He is a very ardent supporter of the military and law enforcement since many members of his family have and currently serve in these capacities. Fr. Stephen, like Bishop Olson, shares a deep love and respect for our Catholic Schools.


