

#### The Lord provides for us!

Our Gospel this 16th Week in Ordinary Time is the continuation to last week's summoning and sending of the apostles. While fulfilling the command of the



Lord to go into the world, the Lord still provides for the apostles. He provides them with an opportunity to join with Him and draw away from the very work He has given them. Often we can feel overwhelmed in the world, not just with the normal activities of our life but also with trying to live the Christian life we are called to live.

The Lord is speaking to us when He speaks to the apostles and invites them to rest with Him. The mass on Sunday, and any day of the week, is our opportunity to join with the Lord. Together as the Body of Christ, we join with our head and offer to the Father the one prayer of Jesus Christ, the mass. The mass is a prayer. It is the highest prayer which we can offer to God. In the mass we are glorifying God by proper worship of Him but we are also sanctified as His people. To be sanctified is to be drawn out of this world and drawn closer to, like unto, God.

The Lord is calling us to Himself not simply to give us our mission but also to provide us rest in Him. We also have another term for this type of rest with our Lord. We call this peace! Peace of mind and peace of heart. In the world you will encounter trouble, but take courage. The Lord has overcome the world! (Jn 16:33) At mass we can encounter His peace because we encounter the Lord Himself. He feeds us. He feeds us with food, bread of the finest wheat! (Ps 81)

Come away from the world! Come and eat! Come and truly be fed!

### Welcome, Principal Flanagan!

Saint Martin de Porres Parish is very excited to welcome Mrs. Susan Flanagan as the Principal of our school! A native of New Jersey, she has been in Catholic Education for the past 14 years, and is currently finishing her school year at Santa Cruz Catholic School in Buda, TX, part of the Austin Diocese. She has a BA in English from La Salle University, an M.S. Ed. in Special Education, and two certificates: Mid-Management from TWU and Gifted and Talented from UNT. She began her teaching career at St. Veronica Catholic School in Howell, NJ and continued teaching English until 2004 when she accepted the principalship at Our Lady of Fatima Catholic School in Texas City, TX. In 2011, she moved to Santa Cruz Catholic School.

Mrs. Flanagan is impressive in many ways. In her past two principal-ships, she doubled the enrollment. Consequently, she was an integral part of the building process at Santa Cruz which involved a 1.7 million dollar expansion to accommodate the new students. Mrs. Flanagan has been the one to develop, maintain, and monitor the school budget, working closely with their business manager, but taking the responsibility herself for forecasting a viable budget that has always ended in the black. She has an outstanding understanding of curriculum and is excited to work with the diocese as we continue to move towards a more classical approach to education. Mrs. Flanagan already has ties to North Texas, as she has 4 of her 5 children living in the area. She and her husband of 21 years are thrilled to be living closer to several of her grandchildren with this transition to Saint Martin de Porres.


