

The School Advisory Council is a consultative board, established by the pastor, to assist him, the school principal, and the school's administration in the governance of the school through support, guidance, and advice - not oversight. The school administration and faculty are responsible for the day-to-day operations of the school. Council members provide input, often drawn from their own professional experiences and backgrounds, in areas such as:

- formulation of school policy (it does not, however, provide final approval or enact policies);
- · planning, development, finance, and institutional advancement; and
- public relations, and evaluation of board and mission effectiveness.

A candidate for the St. Martin de Porres School Advisory Council must be able to commit to one meeting per month for the full board, and participate in committee work as well. Interested parishioners should contact the school office at 469-362-2400 for more information, or to receive the board member information sheet. **Discernment for potential board members will be on Sunday, August 26th, in the school's Chapel at 1:00 PM.**

#### Adult Faith Formation

Volunteers are needed to help facilitate Bible Studies and Faith Sharing groups. Must be a practicing Catholic at least 18 years of age and have received Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.

#### **Altar Servers**

All boys and girls who have received First Communion are invited to serve at the altar.

#### **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion**

All ministers of Holy Communion should show the greatest reverence for the Most Holy Eucharist by their demeanor, their attire, and the manner in which they handle the consecrated bread or wine. You must be at least 18 years of age, in good standing with the church, and have received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation.

#### **Homebound Ministry** (facilities and home visits)

We make an effort to stay connected with those parishioners who are not able to join us as mass due to illness or other incapacities so they know they are not forgotten. This ministry is split into two groups - those who wish to visit <u>facilities</u> on Thursday mornings at 9:30 AM, and Sundays at 10:30 AM and 1:30 PM, and those who visit parishioners in their <u>homes</u>.

#### **Hospitality**

Once a month, they welcome parishioners and serve donuts and coffee after masses.

#### Ladies of St. Zita

Parish Hall housekeeping. We welcome ladies with a devoted desire to maintain the cleanliness of our place of worship. This includes but is not limited to: vacuuming the chapel, "Swiffer" mopping the sacristy floor, dusting pews and kneelers in the chapel, light dusting of window ledges and wall ledges in entries, chapel and parish hall, tidying restrooms, etc.

#### Lectors

A rewarding way to participate in our mass is to proclaim God's Word as a lector.

#### **New Member Welcoming**

These happy people greet and welcome new parishioners, and help them get involved in parish life.

#### Music

Music ministers include choir members, cantors, and instrumentalists.

#### Office Help

#### RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process for individuals who wish to become Catholic. Volunteers are needed in many capacities such as hospitality, group facilitators and sponsors. You must be a practicing Catholic of at least 18 years of age and have received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation to volunteer in RCIA.

#### Sacristans


Sacristans arrive at least 45 minutes prior to mass prepare liturgical vessels, books, bread and wine, and all other materials necessary for the liturgy. They also ensure all scheduled volunteers are present, and find additional volunteers if needed.

#### Safe Environment Volunteer

Assist the Safe Environment Coordinator with clerical support and/or facilitating Safe Environment training classes for children, teens and adults. Please contact Alexis Campbell for application procedures.

#### Ushers

These friendly folks welcome those joining in celebration at each mass, help those arriving to find seats, and take up the collection during mass. They also help dismiss rows for Holy Communion and hand out bulletins as parishioners leave.
