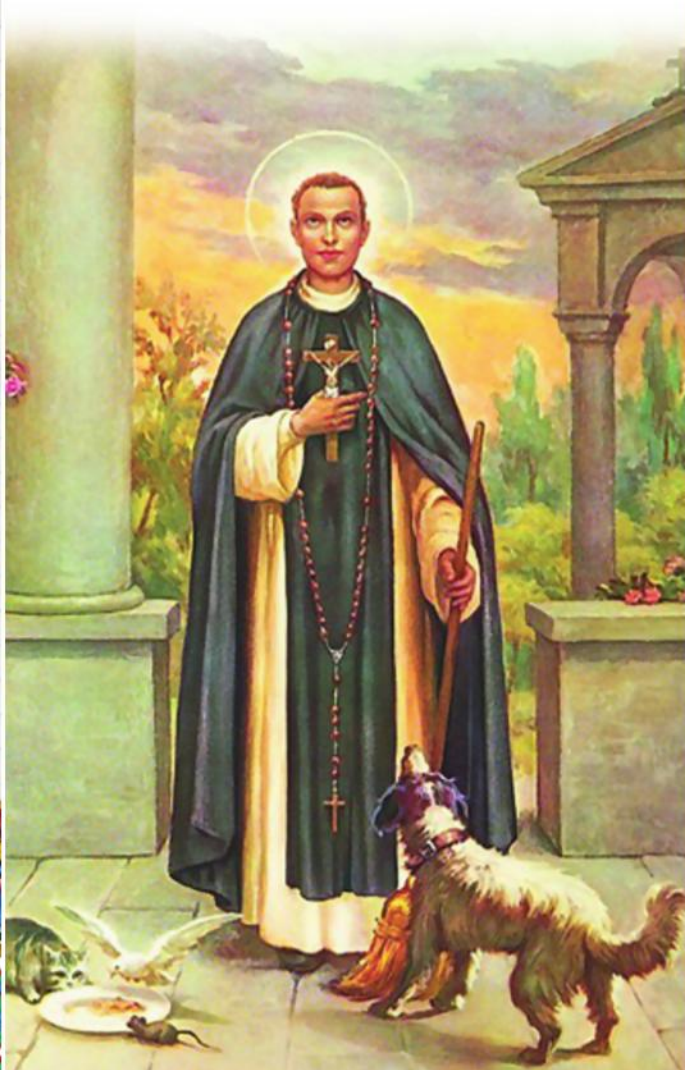

Belief requires grace and action.



As we enter this third week of our journey as a church into the 6th chapter of the Gospel of John, the Lord reveals that He is the true sacrifice, He is the bread of eternal life which we must eat of. The remaining two Sundays will focus more intently on this most fundamental aspects of the gift of the Eucharist. Belief requires grace and action. It is through the grace of the Father that we are able to accept that Jesus is the Lord. It is also the grace of the Father which allows us to respond and partake of the true bread of eternal life, the Eucharist. The Lord is reaffirming that God is with us but desires more. He desires to not simply be with us, but to have us be united to Him in a deeper covenant for eternity. It is not enough for God to journey with us as separate from Him. He offers to us the intimacy of becoming our true food, that which can satisfy our complete hunger in body and soul. In order for a person to enter into a covenant, the person must partake of that which was sacrificed. Anything offered to God when thusly consumed becomes part of us too. This is the way in which we are made one in the covenant. This is also the reason the Jewish people were told not to eat the flesh of animals which had been sacrificed to foreign gods. In the mass we receive as nourishment from the one eternal sacrifice of Jesus the Christ to the Father. This is the covenant which we choose to enter into and choose to be fed by. This is also why we must receive the Eucharist and must work hard to prepare ourselves through prayer and sacramental confession. How well am I seeking to be nourished by God? Am I okay with sacrificing to other gods in my life? May our concern be with giving thanks to God for His great gift of salvation and the gift of allowing us to partake of His sacrifice on our behalf!

The School Advisory Council is a consultative board, established by the pastor, to assist him, the school principal, and the school's administration in the governance of the school through support, guidance, and advice - not oversight. The school administration and faculty are responsible for the day-to-day operations of the school. Council members provide input, often drawn from their own professional experiences and backgrounds, in areas such as:

- formulation of school policy (it does not, however, provide final approval or enact policies);
- planning, development, finance, and institutional advancement; and
- public relations, and evaluation of board and mission effectiveness.

A candidate for the St. Martin de Porres School Advisory Council must be able to commit to one meeting per month for the full board, and participate in committee work as well. Interested parishioners should contact the school office at 469-362-2400 for more information, or to receive the board member information sheet. **Discernment for potential board members will be on Sunday, August 26th, in the school's Chapel at 1:00 PM.**

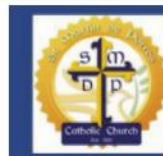
