## The Eucharist and belief in Jesus as God.

The Lord has given to us the standard of our belief! As we hear in this Sunday's Gospel, the Lord reaffirms His state-



ments of the Eucharist as truly His body and blood, true food. This becomes the line by which all of His believers both then and now must hold and also affirm. This is the standard apart from which we cannot call ourselves Christian and certainly cannot call ourselves Catholic. The simple reason is precisely because the Lord is not capable of declaring that His body is true food and His blood true drink if He is not God. This is an act which can only happen if He is in fact God. When the Jews of that time continue to ask our Lord for a sign, when we today continue to ask our Lord for a sign, He responds with a sign which only God can give. The Eucharist is only truly food if Jesus is truly God. The question of the true presence of God in the Eucharist is really the question, is Jesus God? If Jesus is truly God, then the Eucharist is truly His body and blood. The two ideas cannot be held separate. So the question comes back to us. Do I believe and accept that Jesus is truly God? Do I accept this the same way I accept that 2+2=4, as an outer truth which is good to know but doesn't change my daily life? What does it mean to me and in my life that Jesus is God? Am I willing to allow God to show me what it means that Jesus is God? We need not have every answer to every question immediately in order to learn to trust. Can I in my daily life approach the Lord with enough humility to recognize that. I am not God and that God desires to be known to me? He desires this because He loves me. Not because I have been perfect, not because I have earned His love, but because He chooses to love me and has given me life. He loves me and continues to give me life, all the while offering to me eternal life through offering to me His very body and blood in the Eucharist.

Help mentors deliver donations, give rides to necessary appointments and help set-up apartments. Catholic Charities Fort Worth is looking for volunteers for the Gabriel Project. The Gabriel Project offers free help to pregnant women and their families through spiritual encouragement, emotional support and the provision of baby items. We also connect women and families to resources designed to help them achieve their financial, educational and employment goals. All families with a child under 18 months old are eligible.

## What is expected of a Gabriel Project volunteer?

- · Have an updated Safe And Sacred program
- · Attend a Volunteer Orientation and Gabriel Project Training
- · Spend 5- 10 hours a month mentoring through emails, phone calls and in-person
- Be prepared to respond with help when a mentor needs help delivering donations or driving the pregnant woman to an appointment
- · Be willing to attend on-going training quarterly

We would love to have our volunteers commit to the program for as long as you can but we ask for a one year commitment initially. This is a volunteer opportunity that can be done on a time frame that fits your schedule; including weekends and after 5 pm. All appointments can be worked out between you and your Gabriel Project mother.
