FROM THE

The last full measure....she has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood!

This Sunday, as a nation, we recognize and **PASTOR** celebrate our veterans. We rightly acknowledge. the sacrifice which they have made and the ultimate sacrifice which all veterans have offered of their life. A sacrifice which some indeed made. They did so on behalf of their loved ones, on behalf of future generations, and in gratitude for their country, for our country. The reality of any sacrifice is the willing endurance of pain or loss for a greater good. When we find or recognize value, we begin to evaluate the cost to obtain it or preserve that which has value. The veteran is one who, through their service, tells us of the value they recognize by what they are willing to offer, their very life. When we recognize the same value which those who have sacrificed have recognized, we honor the sacrifice they have made and hope to be able to imitate them. Unfortunately, there are some in our country who do not see the value or the sacrifice of our veterans and sadly ignore them and their service. When the Lord calls together His disciples in today's gospel. He does so to share with them the value He has recognized in the sacrifice of the poor widow. The value He sees in the poor widow is her very life. So great is her trust in God that she gives to God when it would seem to be foolish to do so. She relies on God for her livelihood! The Lord is less concerned with a specific amount of money and more concerned with a specific amount of the heart. If we truly believe that God created everything, then money is never a concern to Him, for He can always provide for whatever He desires. The only thing the Lord cannot command is your heart. You must freely choose to give that to Him. His grace allows us to recognize the value in choosing Him. His grace helps us to choose Him. The choice is rightly and definitively ours. His grace helps us make a choice in true freedom as we are ransomed from our sin. We must still make that choice even when those around us do not see the value we see in the Lord. To the world, entrusting our livelihood to God, seems foolish. The reality is that our livelihood already belongs to God and wisdom is when we recognize this and thank God for it! The only fitting gift to God is the one denied Him by Adam, willful obedience and a heart like unto His. God is praised when God is our focus. In the end there will only be One Word, the Word of God Jesus Christ. In the end there will only be One Prayer, the Mass. In the end there will only be One Heart, the great Sacred Heart of Our Lord from which Divine Mercy flows. May our prayer be to recognize the value of so great a gift and begin to sacrifice to obtain it.

In 2007, the Worcester family, along with veterans, and others who had helped with their annual Christmas wreath ceremony in Arlington, formed Wreaths Across America™, to continue and expand this effort, and support other groups around the country who wanted to do the same.
