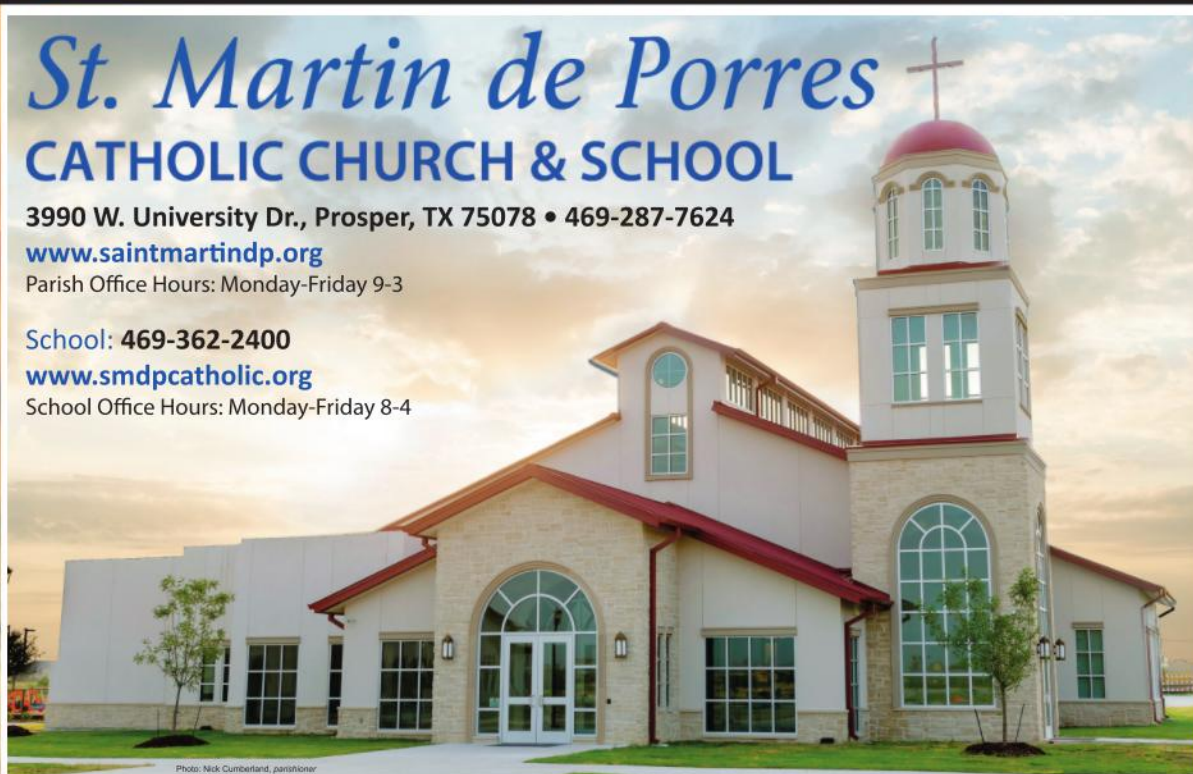

Deacon Jack was ordained in 2008, and comes to us from the Archdiocese of Detroit. He has lived almost his entire life in southeast Michigan. He has been married for 32 years and has four adult children; one of whom lives here in Dallas, while one is a Catholic priest serving in Germany! His wife, Lynette, was a school teacher for 23 years, and just recently retired. He attended the University of Michigan as an undergraduate, and has an M.B.A. from Eastern Michigan University and a Masters in Pastoral Studies from Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit. He founded the Catholic Biblical School of Michigan (CBSM), which is systematic four year study of Sacred Scripture, cross listed with Sacred Heart Major Seminary, where he was adjunct faculty for the last ten years. The program currently has over 500 students in four dioceses.

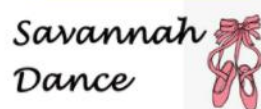

In 2007, the Worcester family, along with veterans, and others who had helped with their annual Christmas wreath ceremony in Arlington, formed Wreaths Across America™, to continue and expand this effort, and support other groups around the country who wanted to do the same.
