



•5:00 – 5:45 PM: Kick-off of Novena For Life and pray the Rosary


• 5:45 – 6:15 PM: Pizza and Refreshments

Background: On January 22, 1973, abortion was legalized in the United States (Roe v. Wade). Since that tragic day, there have been an estimated 61.5 million abortions in the U.S. which, on average, translates to approximately 1,336,957 abortions per year, or 3,663 per day - truly astounding and horrifying figures. Since 1974, each year in late-January, Pro-Life Americans have held a peaceful protest called "The March For Life," which has developed into the largest annual gathering of Pro-Lifers in the country to raise awareness about the evil of abortion, and pray for an end to abortion. On the brighter side, over the past few years, the Pro-Life movement in the U.S. has made some significant gains, and annual abortions have declined to their lowest level since Roe v. Wade was passed.

Now, more than ever, is the time for awareness, action, <u>and prayer</u> that these trends continue towards an END to abortion in our country.

One hundred percent of the proceeds remain in the Diocese to increase available financial aid for qualifying families who desire a quality Catholic education for their children.

Most Reverend Michael Olson, Bishop of Fort Worth, says, "Our Catholic schools are dedicated to integrity of faith entrusted to the Church by Christ and also to the soundness of solid and right reason, where we can come to know the Truth both through faith and reason. Our Catholic education also has to be accessible to all and the **Catholic School Tuition Assistance Fund** makes that accessibility to all that we can have a Catholic education that inconveniences us from complacency and helps us to go into the world with truth that we know through faith and reason."

For more than 100 years, Catholic education in North Texas has focused on preparing young people with quality academics, challenging physical activities and formation in faith. It's been proven over and over again that students graduating from Catholic schools are better prepared for their next level of education and better prepared for life. Studies show they succeed more readily than students who have not had a rigorous college prep education.

Our schools form the future of our Church. Sustaining the long tradition of excellence in our 19 elementary and high schools remains the highest priority in the Diocese of Fort Worth. With this function as our priority, it's interesting that there are 45,196 Catholic students in public schools receiving Catholic formation on Sundays. We know some of them would prefer to glean their religious education in a Catholic school setting but cannot afford tuition. Tuition is an obstacle for some families and the 2018 results of the FACTS independent assessment of about half of those families indicated the tuition need in our Diocese is about seven million dollars.

The **Catholic School Tuition Assistance Fund** was established in 2006 to increase available financial aid for families who demonstrate financial need. The goal is to offer affordable Catholic school education to as many families as wish to send their children to a Catholic school.
