The one prayer is the prayer of Jesus Christ, the Mass. The one heart is the great Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ. Let us follow Our Lord with our whole heart so it may be His Heart!

St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church and School gratefully announces the establishment of the **Father James Cuneo Memorial Endowment**. The fund was created in the name of the late Father James J. Cuneo, to provide tuition assistance for St. Martin de Porres Catholic School students who demonstrate financial need.

Father James J. Cuneo, known to many as Father Jim, was born in Denver, CO on April 18, 1937. He graduated from Holy Family High School in 1955 and entered St. Thomas Seminary. He was ordained to the priesthood at the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Denver by Bishop David M. Maloney on May 25, 1963.

Fr. Cuneo served the Catholic Church as a parish priest, military chaplain, and teacher for 55 years. Because of his patriotic love for his country and soldiers, he received permission from the archdiocese to join the U.S. Air Force for a span of 20 years, during which he served in Korea, Germany, and Turkey during the Gulf War, and as the only priest in Thule, Greenland. He also served as chaplain at Edwards Airforce Base in California and the Lowry Air Force Base in Denver, where he attained the rank of lieutenant colonel.

Before he was called home to God on April 1, 2019, Fr. Cuneo left instructions that any remaining funds after his affairs were settled should be given to any Catholic organization as determined by the executors of his Will. His younger brother, Bob Cuneo, a parishioner of St. Martin de Porres, was one of the executors of Fr. Cuneo's Will.

After reading one of the quarterly financial snapshots published in our weekly bulletin, Bob Cuneo and his family determined that our parish and school met the criteria left by his brother.

In speaking with Bob and his family, and learning more about Fr. Cuneo's ministry and love of Catholic Education, Fr. Stephen Hauck determined it appropriate to use a portion of the funds to establish an endowment in his name to further Catholic Education at St. Martin de Porres Catholic School. In addition to the establishment of the **Father James Cuneo Memorial Endowment**, St. Martin de Porres parish has added April 1st, the anniversary of his death, and May 25th, the anniversary of his ordination, to the permanent Mass Intention schedule for Masses to be said for Fr. Cuneo in perpetuity.

We are thankful for the many gifts that Fr. Cuneo has given to the Catholic Church, and know that the endowment established in his name will benefit countless students long into the future. Details about contributing toward the **Father James Cuneo Memorial Endowment** will be shared in a future bulletin.

In December 1992 in Harrington, Maine, wreath maker Morrill Worcester found himself with a surplus of 5,000 wreaths during the holiday season. Worcester saw the surplus as an opportunity to pay tribute to our country's veterans and with the help of Maine Senator Olympia Snowe, arranged for the wreaths to be placed at Arlington National Cemetery. In 2007, the Worcester family along with veterans and volunteers formed the non-profit organization Wreaths Across America to continue and expand their efforts. Wreaths Across America's mission is simple:

Remember the fallen,
Honor those that serve, and
Teach the next generation about the value of freedom.

In 2019, Wreaths Across America and its national network of volunteers placed 1.8 million veterans' wreaths at over 2,100 locations in all 50 U.S. states, at sea, and abroad. Last year, over 40,000 wreaths were laid at Dallas-Ft. Worth National Cemetery. St. Martin de Porres Catholic School sold almost 1,400 of those wreath sponsorships.

Please help St. Martin de Porres Catholic School reach our goal of selling over 1,500 wreaths this year. Each wreath sponsorship is \$15.00. The school will receive \$5.00 back for each wreath sold through our fundraising efforts. More important:
