When the Israelites gathered more than their daily portion of manna, the surplus became wormy and rotten. In the same way today, self-reliance, pride and ego leads to hoarding and excessive surplus of goods and money. Living a stewardship lifestyle helps us discern our "wants" from our "needs". Living a grateful and generous lifestyle reminds us that God will provide all that we need and that we have plenty to share.



The weekend of August 7-8, Fr. Perry Henry, C.M. will speak at all Masses about the Kenya Mission of the Vincentians. The Vincentians follow Jesus Christ, evangelizing the poor, in the Spirit of their founder, Saint Vincent de Paul. In Kenya, the Vincentian Fathers and Brothers educate and form priests, run a woodworking program to train Kenyans with skills to support their families, and shepherd five parishes with 31 outstations bringing the sacraments to 30,000 people each week. They also help families and children with clean water, food, and medical care through several outreach centers. They are committed to bringing the Gospel to those in need.

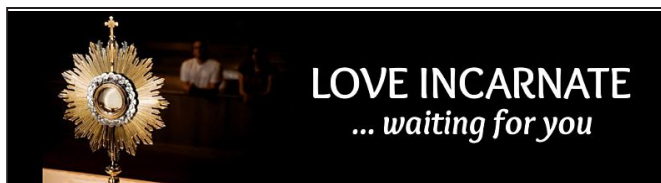

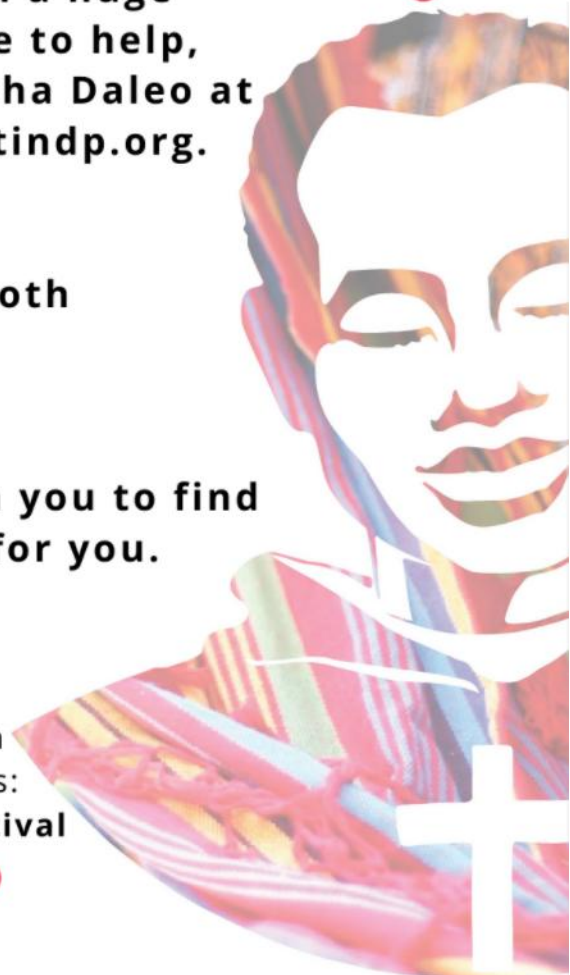

Elevate Middle School Youth Group

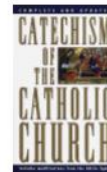
