

7 Sorrows & 7 Joys of St. Joseph

St. Joseph has a special relationship to Jesus and Mary, and we can rely on his powerful intercession in our lives. **To honor end of the Year of St. Joseph, we'll be praying the 7 Sorrows & 7 Joys of St. Joseph prior to all Masses beginning this weekend for 7 consecutive weekends.** These prayers will be led by our Rosary Leader 10 minutes before Mass. Here are the prayers for this week:

1st Sorrow of St. Joseph: Joseph Resolves to leave Mary

“Now this is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. When his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, *but before they lived together, she was found with child through the holy Spirit. Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to put her away quietly.” (Matthew 1:18-19)

1st Joy of St. Joseph: The Annunciation to St. Joseph

“Such was his intention (to divorce Mary) when, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, “Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.” (Matthew 1:20-21)

Let us pray: O Glorious St. Joseph, chaste spouse of Mary Most Holy, what anguish filled your heart when you thought of putting your spouse away privately. Yet your joy was unspeakable when the stupendous mystery of the incarnation was made known to you by the angel. By this sorrow and joy of yours, we ask you to comfort us with the joy of a good life, followed by a holy death, patterned after your own, in the arms of Jesus and Mary.

News from the Principal's Desk

On August 12th we welcomed 212 students to our Catholic school in grades PreK-3 through 8th grade. This is an increase of 70 students over the start of last school year, and for the first time in the history of our school, we now have waiting lists in five different grades. So, our halls are filled with many happy faces!

We are closing in on the end of our first grading quarter, and students have been settling into their daily routines. They have been learning to sight read in music and play Pac Man tag in PE. They have been studying atoms in science and number sense in math. The younger students are learning their letters and sounds, how to write their names, and what it means to be part of a community. The littles are also learning some special prayers like the Our Father, Hail Mary, Morning Offering, and the Prayer to St. Michael. Each day brings new educational experiences in each of the grade levels thanks to the hard work of our exceptional group of teachers.

Athletics is underway with our 5th – 8th grade girls participating in Volleyball. They are learning how to set, serve, and work together as a team. We also are starting up archery this month and getting set to begin boys and girls basketball in November. Besides athletics, we are also preparing for our NTIL Academic Competition in December. Students will compete in various subjects such as reading writing, math, and vocabulary.

Our school is so looking forward to the SMdP Parish Festival in October. Our parents are putting together some wonderful games for the children to enjoy on Sunday, October 24th. It should be a fun-filled day, and I am looking forward to seeing our families and parishioners enjoying themselves on this special day!


