

# 7 Sorrows & 7 Joys of St. Joseph

To honor end of the Year of St. Joseph, we'll be praying the 7 Sorrows & 7 Joys of St. Joseph prior to all Masses beginning this weekend for 7 consecutive weekends. These prayers will be led by our Rosary Leader 10 minutes before Mass. Here are the prayers for this week:

# 1st Sorrow of St. Joseph: Joseph Resolves to leave Mary

"Now this is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. When his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, \*but before they lived together, she was found with child through the holy Spirit. Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to put her away quietly." (Matthew 1:18-19)

# 1st Joy of St. Joseph: The Annunciation to St. Joseph

"Such was his intention (to divorce Mary) when, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." (Matthew 1:20-21)

Our school is so looking forward to the SMdP Parish Festival in October. Our parents are putting together some wonderful games for the children to enjoy on Sunday, October 24th. It should be a fun-filled day, and I am looking forward to seeing our families and parishioners enjoying themselves on this special day!
