

## Upcoming Special Collections

**Pontifical Good Friday Holy Land (April 15)**  
On Good Friday, the Church enters into the mystery of Christ's suffering and death for our salvation. The Church in the Holy Land - the site of Jesus' life, ministry, death and Resurrection - suffers immensely from persecution and instability brought on by war and terrorism. This collection provides many types of support in the region such as humanitarian, pastoral, liturgical, charitable and archaeological.

**Catholic Home Missions (April 23-24)**  
Home mission dioceses are those dioceses in the United States - including its territories, and former territories - that cannot provide basic pastoral services. These include Mass, the sacraments, religious education, and ministry training for priests, deacons, religious sisters, and laypeople without outside help. Right now, nearly 40% of dioceses in United States and its territories are considered home missions.

# Divine Mercy Sunday

A Universal Church Feast  
observed on the  
First Sunday after Easter

Sunday, April 24, 2022

In her *Diary*, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska recorded 14 revelations from our Lord requesting this feast. The most complete, concise description is found in entry 699:

**I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. ... The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.**

To receive the extraordinary graces of this feast, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the vigil celebration) by making a good Confession beforehand and staying in the state of grace, and receive with great trust in Divine Mercy. We also are encouraged to venerate the Divine Mercy Image, and perform acts of mercy through deed, word, or prayer.




