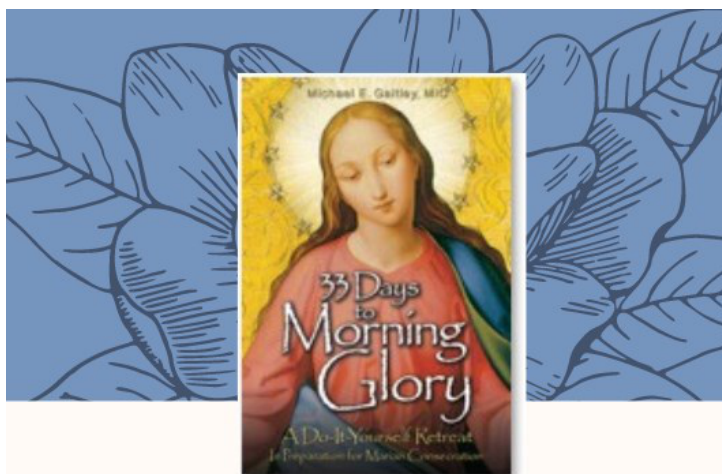

WHEELCHAIR SUNDAY IS THIS WEEKEND!

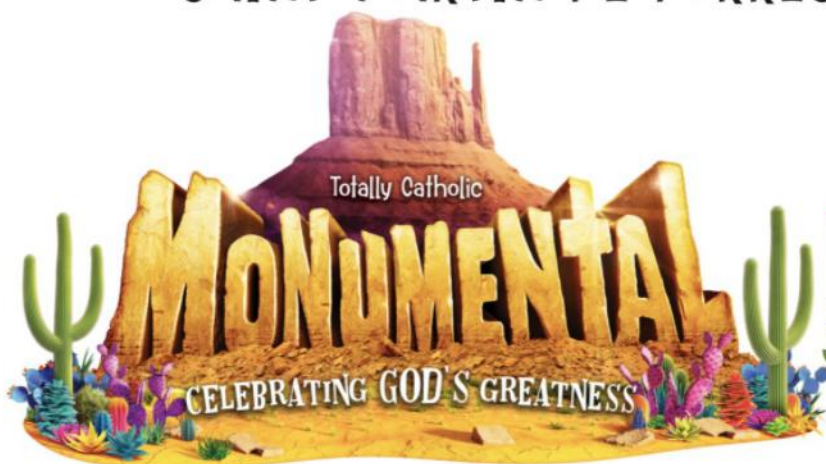
