

A few weeks ago, the Sisters in Jesus the Lord from Vladivostok, Russia, visited our parish. On the weekend of July 30/31, their pastor, Daniel Maurer, CJD, from Mary Mother of God Mission Society and the Vladivostok Mission will visit our parish to speak about the Roman Catholic Mission Churches in Eastern Russia.

Reviving the Roman Catholic Church
in Eastern Russia

In the early 1900's, the Russian Far East boasted a thriving Roman Catholic population. Many Russians, Poles, Lithuanians, and other groups inhabited the area and had built schools, hospitals, and beautiful churches. After the revolution of 1917, Russia became an emblem of the Communist era, a land without churches and without God. Under Stalin, all Catholic churches were confiscated, and Dioceses closed. Most churches were desecrated or destroyed. Catholics were murdered by the hundreds of thousands and their bodies dumped into mass graves.

Two American priests, Fr. Myron Effing, CJD, and Fr. Daniel Maurer, CJD, arrived in Vladivostok in 1992 to help re-establish the Church in the region and provide charitable assistance to the many poor. Now that the foundations have been laid, additional priests and sisters are joining the work, and parishes are growing and multiplying, very slowly, but surely.



Administrative Assistant

Position Summary: The Administrative Assistant will work in the areas of liturgy and administration assisting the Pastor and Business Manager with tasks related to those departments. The Administrative Assistant will also assist with reception duties providing direction and information to all those who contact the Parish Office and will provide administrative and related office services to staff.

Accountabilities for Liturgy:

- Assists with purchasing and maintaining of candles, candle oil, wine, hosts, ashes, palms, altar linens, vestments for clergy and altar servers, and all supplies related to worship.
- Assists with the preparation of Lent and Advent parish reconciliation services, Confirmation, and other special liturgical events, including the needed worship aids and coordinating the setup/breakdown of liturgical spaces.
- Assists with maintaining liturgical minister roles in Ministry Scheduler online software, including ensuring ministers are scheduled to serve at various liturgical functions, adding new ministers to the software system, and communicating when ministers are needed to volunteer.
- For funeral care and wedding ministries, prepares worship aids as required.

Accountabilities for Administration:

- Plans and carries out duties related to special events – staff lunches, retreats, and volunteer appreciation events.
- Responsible for ordering supplies for various other ministries as requested
- Composes correspondence to parishioners.
- Reviews and coordinates the parish events calendar.
- Greets parishioners, visitors, and guests; determines the purpose of each person's visit and directs or escorts him or her to the appropriate location.
- Answers, screens, and directs phone calls to staff; responds to inquiries and takes messages.
- Responsible for entering new parishioner information into the parish database and related communication portals.
- Assists in entering parishioner tithing information in parish database.
- Accurately notates sacramental records in the Sacramental Records book and communicates with other parishes regarding these.
- Maintains the Mass Intention calendar and related records.
- Receives mail, documents, packages, and courier deliveries and delivers or distributes items.
- Maintains inventory of office supplies and places orders as needed.
- Performs administrative and clerical support tasks to parish staff and visitors, as needed.
- Performs basic filing and recordkeeping.
- Responsible for all other projects and tasks as assigned.


